

Addressing Learning Loss/Gaps

Strategic Plan Goal:

All students will demonstrate continuous academic growth leading to college, career and life success.

<u>Academic Supports</u>: Research is clear, there is no substitute for a high-quality, in-person teaching experience to ensure student academic success. As we return to full-time in-person instruction we will focus on:

- Use of academic testing to identify learning gaps
- Research-based curricular programs/resources
- Implementing after-school academic support programs
- Hire personnel to support students experiencing learning loss

- In-school reading interventions
- Purchase of educational technology and infrastructure

- In-school math interventions
- Implementing activities and services related to summer learning
- Addressing the needs of children from low-income families, children with disabilities, English learners, racial and ethnic minorities, students experiencing homelessness, and foster care youth

Social Emotional Learning (SEL)

Strategic Plan Goal:

All students will attend school in a safe, supportive and engaging environment.

<u>Social/Emotional Supports</u>: We recognize that living through a global pandemic has taken an emotional toll on our students. It is clear that schools will play a vital role in helping students process their lived experiences and deal with any trauma the pandemic may have caused. As we return to full-time in-person instruction we will:

- Implement research-based SEL programs
- Hire additional social work staff to provide extended social work/counseling support for students who experienced trauma
- Work with Regional Superintendent's Office (ROE) to expand SEL services/supports in district

IncludED: Dignity and Belonging

Strategic Plan Goals:
