




LTHS Math Placement



2017-18 D105 Student Progress Overall Spring-Spring Progress




District 105 Math Progress Spring-Spring FY18 Percentage of Students Meeting Annual Growth Target

District 105 Reading Progress Spring-Spring FY18 Percentage of Students Meeting Annual Growth Target






2017-18 D105 Student Achievement Overall Year-End Achievement Results





Percentage of Students Meeting Annual Progress Target by <u>Percentile Range</u>




District 105 Reading Progress Spring-Spring FY18

Percentage of Students Meeting Annual Progress Target By <u>Percentile Range</u>




District 105 Math Progress Spring-Spring FY18





Percentage of students at or above 50th percentile (Overall = 125 : Hispanic = 56)




Current 6th Grade Cohort - Math

Percentage of students at or above 50th percentile (Overall = 123 : Hispanic = 45)





Percentage of students at or above 50th percentile (Overall = 129 : Hispanic = 37)





Percentage of students at or above 50th percentile (Overall = 123 : Hispanic = 47)





Percentage of students at or above 50th percentile




Current 5th Cohort - Reading

Percentage of students at or above 50th percentile (Overall = 124 : Hispanic = 56)




Current 6th Grade Cohort - Reading

Percentage of students at or above 50th percentile (Overall = 126 : Hispanic = 47)





Percentage of students at or above 50th percentile (Overall = 128 : Hispanic = 37)












