Dear Seventh Avenue Parents/Guardians,

Our Halloween activities will begin Thursday, October 31st at 2:00 with our annual Halloween parade. Weather permitting; students will parade around the perimeter of school building. Parents are invited to view the parade by finding a place along the sidewalk where you can take pictures and greet your child. I would highly suggest being lined up outside by 1:45pm so you don't miss your child. After the parade, students, teachers, and room parents only will return to the classrooms to begin their Halloween parties.

In the past, many of our students have gone home for lunch on this day and changed into their costumes at home. To give everyone time to eat lunch and put on their costumes, all students will have an hour lunch on October 31st. **Lunch for all students will be from 11:30 – 12:30.** Students who stay at school on that day will have time to eat lunch and change into their costumes. If needed, assistance with costumes will be given to younger students. ****Due to this assistance, please make sure that if your child comes home for lunch, he/she does not return to school until 12:30 since our lunch/recess supervisors will be busy supervising and helping the students who stay at school.** Students that go home for lunch should line back up at the front doors by the main office. At 12:30 a staff member will greet them and bring them back into the building. Teachers will take attendance at 12:40 to ensure we have all students back from lunch.

As a reminder, do not send your child to school in the morning dressed for Halloween. The following guidelines have been approved by all DI05 Elementary Principals for Halloween:

- No costumes depicting excessive violence (no fake blood, please)
- No weapons of any kind (squirt guns, chains, whips, plastic swords, etc.)
- Keep make-up to a minimum (there is only a short time given to students to get into costumes, so save the best for trick-or-treating)
- **NO ONE MAY WEAR MAKE-UP TO SCHOOL IN THE MORNING**
- Masks must be appropriate for the school setting and your child should be able to see through his/her mask.
- We are asking that our communities refrain from clown costumes this year as many of our students are frighten by this.

In addition, room parents have been planning fun activities for each class. ***Please do not send in any additional food/candy on that day.*** Students will not be allowed to pass out treats in class, nor should they bring treats or candy to distribute.

All students who plan to go home for lunch on October 31st must sign and return the permission slip. Only those students who return that form will be allowed to go home for lunch on Halloween. Thank you for your assistance in making this a safe and fun time for Seventh Avenue students.
