-Do not text and ride your bike. Just as with driving a car, you need to be focused on where you are going and what you're doing so you see everything around you like cars, other bikes, pedestrians, and other items that you might hit, or be hit by.  
  
-You need to stay on the side of the street and out of the middle. You should not be riding individually or in a group in the middle of the street.  
  
-Do not assume that a car or other vehicle sees you. You need to make sure you're safe and that they see you before you ride across an intersection, etc. There are many distracted drivers on the road – be sure they see you.  
  
-Be safe and be sure you are aware of everything around you.
