It was last year on Friday, March 13th, 2020, when we sent students home for what we hoped would be a few weeks to slow the spread of the virus. Now, a year later, we continue to be impacted by COVID. Throughout all of this I have been so proud and continually impressed by the resilience of our students and how they continue to work hard and focus on their learning along with doing what they need to do to keep themselves, their families, and their community safe. I am also proud of our staff and how they continue to adapt and work so hard to support students. Thanks to all of you, our families, for your support and flexibility throughout this unique school year. What an amazing community we are a part of.

When we return from Spring Break, time typically moves very quickly through the remainder of the third trimester and while this year has been so different from anything we have experienced before, I have no doubt time will move along at a rapid pace.

We are currently working on planning for the end of the year and the events that would typically take place. More information will be coming soon. The date of graduation and time (May 24th at 7pm) has not changed but we are not sure what the event will look like.

In April/May, students will take the IAR (Illinois Assessment of Readiness) assessment. Students are taking five assessments over the course of four days. There are two tests for reading/language arts and three for math. Testing will take place on April 27^{th} and 28^{th} for reading and May 3^{rd} and 4^{th} for math.

Gurrie Middle School Library, in coordination with the PTO, will proudly welcome author Kenneth Oppel on April 15th through a virtual visit. Oppel is the author of *Bloom*, a fictional title that describes a time when invasive species affect the planet, seen through the eyes of three young teens. The plant is described as "tall, black, spiky grass" that starts growing all over the world. The title is a great fit due to the current pandemic conditions and also because 7th graders learn about invasive species within their science curriculum.

Oppel will introduce readers to the weird and fascinating world of toxic, invasive and carnivorous plant species. He will also talk about his creative process, from brainstorming, outlining, and successive drafts to finished book.
