Dear Parent:

Beginning April 4th, we will begin administering the PARCC (Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers) Performance Based Assessment.

This test assesses students on the Common Core English-Language Arts and Math standards. Our Gurrie teachers have aligned classroom instruction to the standards and are sharing sample test items with students. Students in seventh and eighth grade will be taking six assessments, three in reading and three in math. Students will take the assessments using their Chromebooks and complete one assessment per day, completing the final assessment on April 12th. Specific testing days are April 4th, 5th, 6th, 10th, 11th, and 12th. After completing an assessment, students will follow an adjusted class schedule.

Students who are absent or tardy will need to make up the tests they missed during the testing window. It is very important that students are here and taking the tests during the designated times.

Estimados Padres:

Empezando Lunes el 16 de Marzo, nosotros empezaremos la administrando de los Asesoramientos Basados en la Interpretación de Evaluaciones PARCC (Asociación para Asesoramientos en preparación para la Universidad o un Carrera.)

Esta prueba, lo cual remplace ISAT, asesorara a los estudiantes en los nuevos Estándares Estatales Comunes en el Arte del Lenguaje-Ingles y Estándares en Matemáticas. La prueba está dividida en dos partes, la evaluación es basa en Interpretación dada en Marzo y al *fin del año* (EOY) prueba administrada al principio de Mayo (mas información ira a casa en los próximos meses referente los asesoramientos EOY.) Durante los últimos dos años, nuestros maestros de Gurrie han alineado las instrucciones de salón a los nuevos estándares y están compartiendo ejemplos de pruebas con los estudiantes. Estudiantes de 7 y 8 grado tomaran 5 asesoramientos, tres en lectura y dos en matemáticas. En Gurrie, los estudiantes tomaran los asesoramientos usando los Chromebooks (tabletas) y completaran un asesoramiento por día, completando la prueba final el Viernes, 20 de Marzo.

Estudiantes que estén ausentes o tarde tendrán que recuperar las pruebas pérdidas durante la semana del 23 de Marzo. Es muy importante que los estudiantes estén aquí y tomar las pruebas durante los horarios designados.

Dear Parents and Guardians,

With Illinois's adoption of the Common Core State Standards, the **PARCC** (Partnership of Assessment Readiness for College and Career), a state-mandated assessment, is given to 3rd-8th grade students each spring. Beginning this week, 3rd – 8th grade students in District 105 will be taking the PARCC assessment. This test is intended to measure student learning against the Common Core State Standards in both Math and English-Language Arts. These PARCC student results, along with classroom observations, pre and post unit assessments, and MAP information are used to help determine the needs and strengths of our District 105 students. All this information is used, together to determine student learning over time and help inform our instruction to best meet student needs.

Over the last four years, District 105 teachers have been working diligently to best prepare our students for success not only on PARCC but in mastering the Common Core grade level standards as a whole. Teachers have aligned instructional units to address grade level Common Core Math and ELA standards and continue to execute increasingly rigorous daily instruction. District wide pre and post unit assessments, along with frequent progress "check-ins" throughout instructional units, inform teachers of your child's growth toward mastery of the Common Core grade level standards. Teachers are focused on making informed instructional decisions throughout each unit which is essential in preparing your child to be college and career ready and setting them up for success on PARCC.

Some key information:

- All 3rd-8th grade students will participate in the online PARCC assessment.

Though the PARCC assessment window will continue through April 20th, it is important to mention that our students will not be testing that entire time. Our principals have created detailed schedules to stagger testing and maximize instructional blocks with students. Furthermore, as the testing window has been approaching, teachers have been familiarizing students with features unique to the PARCC assessment. Having students comfortable with the format and features of the assessment will allow students to best express their knowledge.

Specific testing schedules for each school and grade will be shared by building principals prior to the start of the testing window. Please do not hesitate to reach out to your building principal, classroom teacher, or me with any PARCC related questions. Looking forward to a successful final trimester of the year!

Estimados Padres y Guardianes,

Con la adopción del estado de Illinois de los Estándares Estatales Comunes, **PARCC** (Asociación de Evaluación de Preparación para la Universidad y Carrera), una evaluación ordenada por el estado, es dada a los estudiantes de 3^º-8^º grado cada primavera. Comenzando en este abril, los estudiantes de 3^º-8^º grado del Distrito 105 tomarán la evaluación PARCC. Esta prueba intenta medir el aprendizaje del estudiante contra los Estándares Estatales Comunes en Matemáticas y en Artes del Idioma Inglés. Los resultados de PARCC de los estudiantes, en conjunto con observaciones en el salón de clase, evaluaciones pre y post de la unidad, e información del MAP se usan para ayudar a determinar las necesidades y fortalezas de nuestros estudiantes en el Distrito 105. Toda esta información es usada, en conjunto para determinar el aprendizaje de los estudiantes en el tiempo y ayuda a la información de nuestra instrucción para encontrar lo mejor que nuestros estudiantes necesiten.

En los últimos tres años, los maestros del Distrito 105 han estado trabajando diligentemente para darles la mejor preparación a los estudiantes para el éxito no solo en PARCC sino en dominar los Estándares Comunes Estatales al nivel del grado. Los Maestros han alineado las unidades de instrucción para direccionar el nivel de grado del Estándar Común en matemáticas y los estándares del ELA y continuar ejecutando la instrucción rigurosa cada día. Evaluaciones pre y post de unidades en el Distrito, junto con "chequeos" frecuentes del progreso por intermedio de unidades de instrucción, le dejan saber a los maestros del crecimiento de sus niños en la maestría de los Estándares Comunes de nivel de grado básico. Los Maestros están enfocados en hacer decisiones de instrucción a lo largo de cada unidad, lo cual es esencial para la preparación de sus niños en estar listos para la Universidad y Carrera y alistándolos para el éxito en PARCC.

Nuestros principales han creado horarios detallados para escalar las pruebas y maximizar los bloques de instrucción con los estudiantes. Más aun, al aproximarse las pruebas, los maestros han estado familiarizando a los estudiantes con propiedades únicas de la evaluación PARCC. Teniendo a los estudiantes cómodos con el formato y propiedades de la evaluación permitirá que ellos expresen mejor sus conocimientos.

Los principales compartirán los Horarios específicos de las pruebas para cada escuela y grado antes del comienzo del periodo de pruebas. Por favor no duden en ver a su principal, maestra de clase, o a mí para cualquier pregunta relacionada con PARCC. Esperamos tener un exitoso final de trimestre del año!

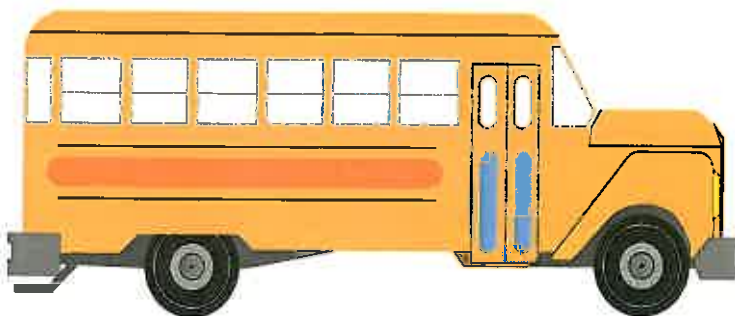
