



#### Kindergarten Registration Information:

If your child will be five years old on or before September 1, 2019, he/she is eligible to enroll in kindergarten for the 2019-2020 school year. Plan now to attend Kindergarten Registration Night, a special evening introducing you to our Kindergarten Program. This evening is designed for <u>parents only.</u> A Kindergarten Tea will be scheduled later to introduce your *child* to the kindergarten room and teacher.

You will be selecting Full-Day or Half-Day Kindergarten for your child at this Registration.

#### Requirements for Registration:

- 1. Regulations relating to kindergarten enrollment provide that a child must be age 5 by September 1, 2019 in order to enroll in kindergarten for that school year (Section 10-20.12 of The School Code of Illinois).
- 2. Acceptable proof of age consists of a <u>certified</u> birth certificate containing the birth registration number. A hospital certificate is **not** acceptable.




