Dear D105 parents and guardians,

District 105 annually seeks feedback from all stakeholders by surveying our students, staff, and parents. This process has taken place in D105 for more than 10 years, and the feedback we receive is invaluable. Annual survey results provide our administration and Board of Education with information to celebrate our success and problem solve our challenges.

Every other year, D105 administers a statewide survey called **5Essentials: Organizing Schools for Improvement**. This survey gives our families the opportunity to provide feedback to our schools and district, as well as help us create an even stronger community. The purpose of the survey is to measure the “five essential” qualities of successful schools. These qualities include *Effective Leaders, Collaborative Teachers, Involved Families, Supportive Environment, and Ambitious Instruction*.

The survey should take about 10 minutes to complete, and we must have at least 20 percent of our families at each school submit a survey in order to receive the results from the state. If you have more than one child attending a D105 school, you are able to complete the survey more than once. If you have children in more than one D105 school, I encourage you to complete the survey for each school.

The results of these surveys will be shared with the D105 Board of Education and posted on our district webpage. The results will also be included on our school report cards that are issued by the State of Illinois. For the first time, these results will impact the ratings of our schools. Because of this, it is even more critical that we receive feedback from the vast majority of our families.
