Did You Know?

- Twenty-six of our 4th-8th graders competed in the Math Olympiad hosted by Western Springs District 101. Our 4th-5th grade team of Adrian Karlovic, Samantha Lameter, Andy Sherman, and Donovan Colville won the event. Andy Sherman was the 4th-5th grade individual winner. Eleven area schools and districts were represented at this event.
- Susan Yeager and London Shannon-Muscolino won Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR) Awards for their essays about American history. London has moved to regional recognition level.
- Fifteen Gurrie students participated in the West 40 Speech and Drama Contest on March 10th. Shannon Miller and Jeanne Mardegan received first place scores in individual events. Jade Babb, Karla Hernandez, and Gabby Quintana received first place recognition in the trio category.
- Stephanie Kubitz, 5th grade teacher at Seventh Avenue School and Gail Housman, 4th grade teacher at Ideal School received the West Suburban Chamber of Commerce Under 40 Young Professionals Award for Excellence.

Steve Bahn Contract Approval

Congratulations to Steve Bahn whose three year contract as “Superintendent Designee” in 2017-18 and “Superintendent” for 2018-2020 was approved by the School Board on February 26th. Steve Bahn was the successful principal of Ideal School for ten years prior to being named Assistant Superintendent in 2016-17. Steve brings excellent leadership skills and a commitment to District 105 success to his new role.

Mid-Year Goals Progress Report

Kathryn Heeke, Director of Curriculum and Instruction, presented district mid-term reading and math achievement results to the School Board at meetings in January and February. Below are highlights of this presentation which can be found on the district website under the School Board – Presentations tab.

- The percentage of students achieving at or above the 50th percentile in math was 61% in math and 68% in reading. These achievement levels are significantly above trend results.
- The percentage of students making their spring to winter progress targets was consistent with the district’s target of ranking above the 90th percentile nationally.
- The district cohort (studying the same students across multiple grade levels) study shows that the longer students are in District 105, the better they perform on MAP reading and math when compared with national peers.

- Quince estudiantes de Gurrie participaron en el Concurso de Discurso y Drama de West 40 el 10 de marzo. Shannon Miller y Jeanne Mardegan recibieron puntajes de primer lugar en eventos individuales. Jade Babb, Karla Hernández y Gabby Quintana recibieron el primer lugar en la categoría trío.
- Stephanie Kubitz, maestra de 5° grado en la Escuela Seventh Avenue y Gail Housman, maestra de 4° grado en la Escuela Ideal recibieron el Premio de Excelencia de West Suburban Chamber of Commerce para Jovenes Profesionales Menores de 40.

Aprobación del Contrato de Steve Bahn

Steve Bahn fue el principal exitoso de La Escuela de Ideal por diez años antes de ser nombrado Asistente del Superintendente en 2016-17. Steve aporta excelentes habilidades de liderazgo y compromiso con el éxito del Distrito 105 a su nuevo rol.

Informe de Progreso de las Metas de Mitad de Año

Kathryn Heeke, Directora de Currículo e Instrucción, presentó los resultados de éxito de lectura y matemática de mitad del trimestre a la Junta Escolar en reuniones en enero y febrero. A continuación se muestran los aspectos más destacados de esta presentación que se pueden encontrar en el sitio web del distrito en la pestaña Junta de la Junta Escolar.

- El porcentaje de estudiantes que lograron el percentil 50 o superior en matemáticas fue del 61% en matemáticas y del 68% en lectura. Estos niveles de logro son significativamente superiores a los resultados de tendencia.
- El porcentaje de estudiantes que lograron sus objetivos de progreso de primavera a invierno fue consistente con el objetivo del distrito de clasificar por encima del percentil 90 a nivel nacional.
- El estudio de la cohorte del distrito (que estudia los mismos estudiantes en varios niveles de grado) muestra que los estudiantes que están en el Distrito 105 por más tiempo, se desempeñan mejor en prueba de MAP en lectura y matemáticas en comparación con sus pares nacionales.

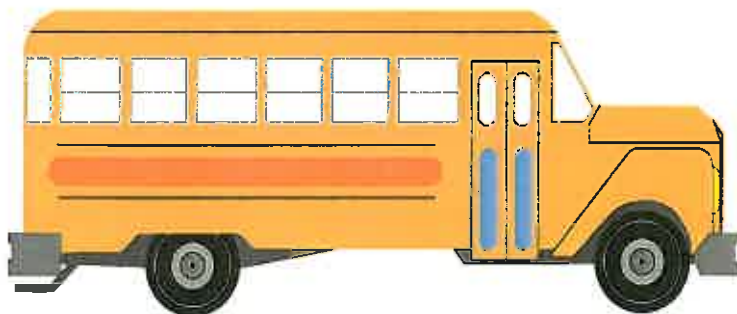

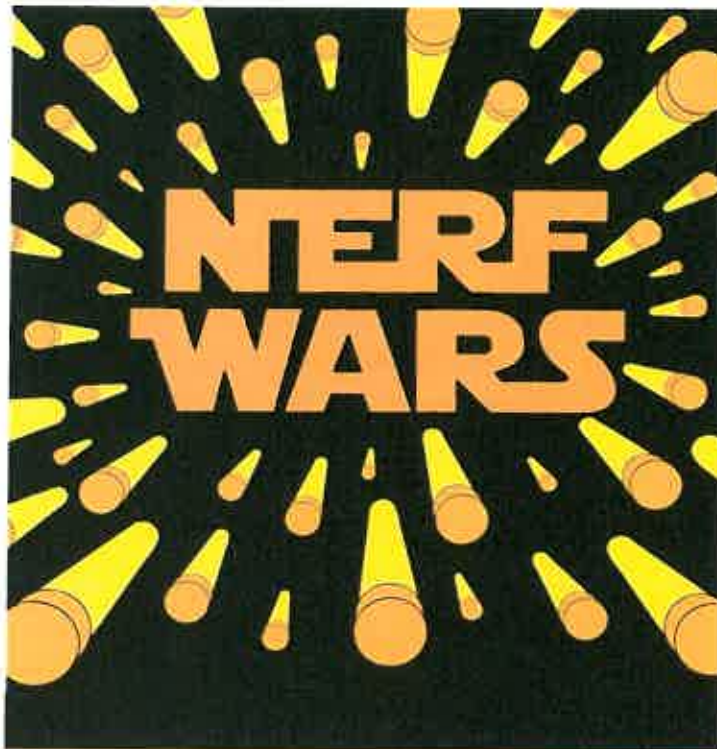
