Dear District 105 Families,

Unfortunately, the media has been reporting on the recent interest in a viral social media trend, "The Momo Challenge". We are sharing this communication to assure you that we are aware, and we are vigilant in monitoring your child's internet use in school. The district internet filters prevent and block content that is not school appropriate. The challenge encourages students to contact an unknown person called, "Momo" via WhatsApp, YouTube or Facebook. Through this challenge, students are sent violent and graphic images and texts. If students want to stop the challenge, "Momo" threatens to leak their personal information. Students are asked to share photos and videos of themselves completing certain tasks of escalating intensity, with a final encouragement from "Momo" for the student to commit suicide.

It is important for you to be aware of this social media trend, and if your child is considering participating in it. Children participating in this challenge are in danger, and are actively communicating with strangers who intend to encourage self-harm. Please consider these tips to supporting safe internet access on computers, smartphones and tablets:

- **Talk about it.** Though we can't always be with our tweens and teens to prevent dangerous behavior, our words really can stay with them. Say, "If you ever want to do an internet challenge, check with me first."
- **Get them to think.** Help your child think through the challenges and whether they're safe or have potential risks. Say, "Walk through each step and figure out where things could go wrong."
- **Acknowledge peer pressure.** Today's kids think of internet personalities as their peers, so seeing kids on YouTube doing a challenge could influence your child. Say, "Why do you want to do this? Is this a video of yourself that you really want out in the world?"
- **Model responsible online habits.** Some parents are the ones recording their children taking these challenges, so make sure your involvement sends the message you intend. Today it might be harmless, but tomorrow it might be more dangerous. Help your kids make the distinction so they can stay safe. (Source: Common Sense Media)

Two weeks ago, we hosted a great presentation in our district from Detective Rich Wistocki, a nationally-recognized expert on Internet Safety, and how internet access impacts our students. As always, we encourage you to be proactive in monitoring your own child's internet use and social media interactions. Should your child give you any cause for concern, please take the appropriate steps. If there is anything that you feel needs to be addressed in school, please let your child's teacher know directly.

Queridas Familias del Distrito 105,

Desafortunadamente, los medios sociales han estado informando sobre una tendencia reciente llamada, "The Momo Challenge" (El Desafío del Momo). Compartimos esta comunicación para asegurarle que somos conscientes, y estamos vigilando y monitoreando el uso de Internet de su hijo en la escuela. Los filtros de Internet del distrito impiden y bloquean el contenido que no es apropiado para la escuela. El desafío anima a los estudiantes a ponerse en contacto con una persona desconocida llamada "Momo" a través de WhatsApp, YouTube o Facebook. A través de este desafío, se envían a los estudiantes imágenes y textos violentos y gráficos. Si los estudiantes quieren detener el desafío, "Momo" amenaza con filtrar su información personal. También les pide a los estudiantes que compartan fotos y videos de ellos mismos completando ciertas tareas de intensidad creciente, con un estímulo final de "Momo" para que el estudiante se suicide.

Es importante que usted este consciente de esta tendencia en las redes sociales, y si su hijo está considerando participar en él. Los niños que participan en este desafío están en peligro y se están comunicando activamente con extraños que pretenden alentar el hacerse daño a sí mismos. Por favor, considere estos consejos para apoyar el acceso seguro a Internet en computadoras, smartphones y tabletas:

- **Hable sobre esto.** Aunque no siempre podemos estar con nuestros niños para prevenir comportamientos peligrosos, nuestras palabras realmente pueden permanecer con ellos. Diga, "si alguna vez quieres hacer un desafío por Internet, consulta primero conmigo."
- **Hágalos que piensen.** Ayude a su hijo a pensar cuidadosamente si los desafíos son seguros o tienen riesgos potenciales. Dígale: "ve paso a paso y averigua dónde las cosas podrían salir mal".
- **Reconozca la presión de los compañeros.** Los niños de hoy piensan sienten que las personalidades del Internet son como sus compañeros, así que ver a los niños en YouTube haciendo un desafío podría influir en su hijo. Dígale, "¿por qué quieres hacer esto? ¿Es este un video tuyo que realmente quieres que lo vea todo el mundo?"
- **Modelar hábitos en línea responsables.** Algunos padres son los que graban a sus hijos haciendo estos desafíos, así que asegúrese de que su participación envíe el mensaje que desea. Hoy podría ser inofensivo, pero mañana podría ser más peligroso. Ayude a sus hijos a hacer la distinción para que puedan estar a salvo. (Fuente: Common Sense media)

Hace dos semanas, fuimos anfitriones de una presentación en nuestro distrito del detective Rich Wistocki, un experto, reconocido nacionalmente, en seguridad de Internet, y cómo el acceso a Internet impacta a nuestros estudiantes. Una breve sinopsis de su presentación está disponible en: [Wistocki Ted Talk: Naperville](#) si usted no pudo acompañarnos en esta presentación, por favor considere ver este video. Como siempre, lo animamos a que sea proactivo en el monitoreo del uso de Internet de su propio hijo y las interacciones de las redes sociales. Si su hijo le preocupa, por favor tome las medidas apropiadas. Si hay algo que usted siente que debe ser considerado en la escuela, por favor deje que el maestro de su hijo lo sepa directamente.

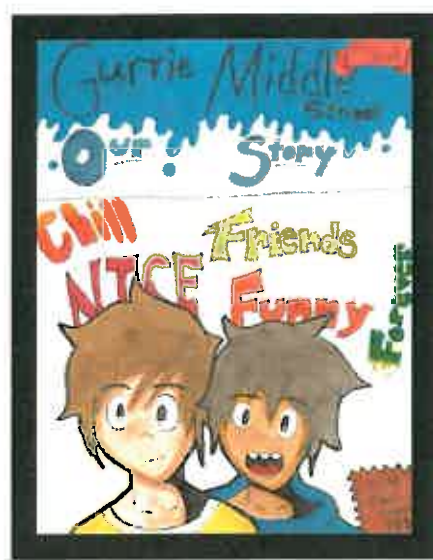

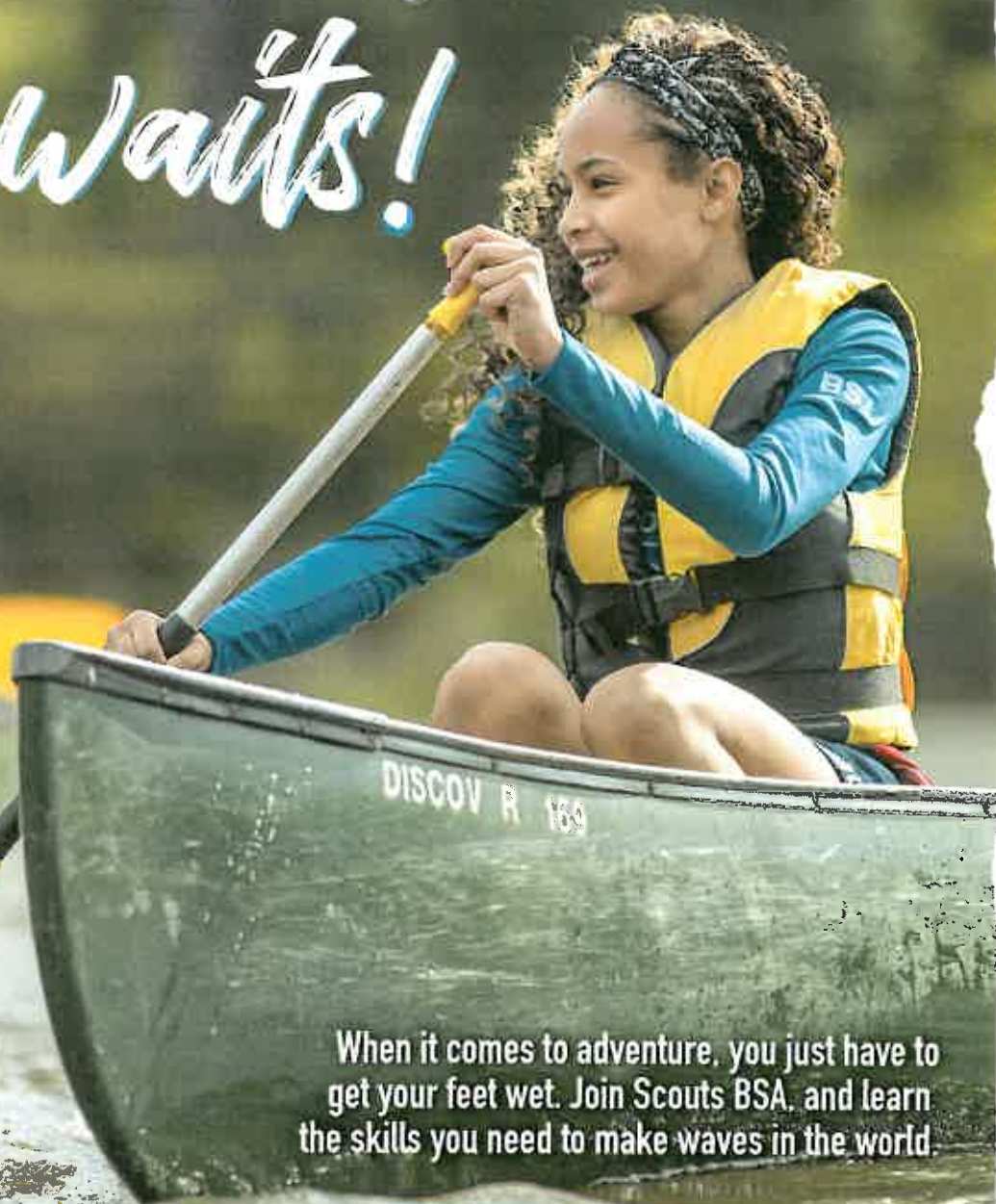
