Dear District 105 Parents,

I am writing to you after the heartbreaking school shooting in Parkland, Florida. Reverberations following this tragedy have extended well beyond the Parkland community. Throughout the country, there is a heightened awareness about all matters related to school security. With this in mind, I want to communicate our plans for March 14, the date of the nationwide student walkout, and to reassure you about our ongoing district-wide attention to school safety and security.

As you may be aware, there are nationwide plans for a student walkout on March 14. The walkout is being explained as a means for students to express their dissatisfaction with gun violence, specifically in schools. While we are unsure what to expect from our students on this day, we have prepared for a wide variety of student responses to this peaceful demonstration day. We anticipate that Gurrie Middle School will likely have a reasonable participation level and our elementary schools relatively small involvement. Our district staff members will not initiate or sponsor these protests. But we will provide for the safety and security of any students who wish to peacefully demonstrate by walking out, while at the same time supporting them in a manner which recognizes their ages and developmental levels. Our plans include having staff members remain inside classrooms for students who choose not to walk out, as well as having supervisory staff with students who choose to participate. We will direct students to a pre-designated inside or outside area at each of our school sites. The walkout will begin at 10:00 A.M. and last seventeen minutes in memory of the seventeen students and staff members who lost their lives in Parkland. Our plan is for all students who participate in this protest to return to their classrooms after these seventeen minutes. **We are requiring parent written permission (an email or note to the principal) for elementary school students to participate in this walkout. We will not permit elementary students to leave classrooms without this permission. Middle school parents may contact their principal if they do not want their child participating in the walkout.**

We have spent years working with our first responders to continuously evaluate and improve our safety and security plans and procedures. We have Comprehensive Crisis Response Plans which were developed with our first responders in place at each school. We review these plans annually with our first responders who oversee our school-wide drills to practice these plans. In addition, our first responders make special efforts to be visible in and around our schools, and they are always available to investigate any matters of safety. Our district also continues to support the enhanced security of our facilities. Secure entrances with video coverage were added to all schools during our 2010-12 renovations. Our video coverage also includes common interior areas and all exterior doors. Our first responders have 24/7 access to this video coverage.

Please realize that the caring, respectful, and trusting relationships that characterize all of our school communities are still our greatest safety measure. Our students and families know that they can communicate with trusted adults when they see or hear something of concern. They trust that our school personnel will investigate and address these concerns in a proactive, thorough, and professional manner.

Estimados Padres del Distrito 105,

Les estoy escribiendo después del tiroteo angustioso en la escuela de Parkland, Florida. Las repercusiones después de esta tragedia se han extendido mucho más allá de la comunidad de Parkland. En todo el país, existe una mayor conciencia sobre todos los asuntos relacionados con la seguridad escolar. Con esto en mente, quiero comunicarles nuestros planes para el 14 de marzo, la fecha de una huelga estudiantil a nivel nacional y para tranquilizarlos sobre nuestra atención continua en todo el distrito a la seguridad y protección de la escuela.

Como usted puede saber, hay planes nacionales para una huelga estudiantil el 14 de marzo. La huelga está siendo explicada como un medio para que los estudiantes expresen su insatisfacción con la violencia con armas de fuego, específicamente en las escuelas. Ya que no sabemos que esperar de nuestros estudiantes en este día, nos estamos preparando para una gran variedad de respuestas de los estudiantes para este día de demostración. Anticipamos que la Escuela Media de Gurrie probablemente tenga un nivel de participación razonable y que nuestras escuelas primarias tengan una participación relativamente pequeña. Los miembros del personal de nuestro distrito no iniciarán ni patrocinarán estas protestas. Pero brindaremos protección y seguridad a los estudiantes que deseen manifestarse pacíficamente saliendo de la escuela, mientras que al mismo tiempo apoyándolos de una manera que reconozca sus edades y niveles de desarrollo. Nuestros planes incluyen el tener miembros del personal que permanezcan dentro de los salones de clases para los estudiantes que deciden no salirse de la escuela, así como tendremos personal de supervisión con los estudiantes que decidan participar.

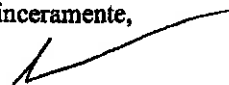
Dirigiremos a los estudiantes a un área designada dentro o fuera de la escuela en cada una de nuestras escuelas. La huelga comenzará a las 10:00 a.m. por diecisiete minutos en memoria de los diecisiete estudiantes y miembros del personal que perdieron la vida en Parkland. Nuestro plan es que todos los estudiantes que participen en esta protesta regresen a sus salones después de estos diecisiete minutos. **Requerimos permiso escrito de los padres (un correo electrónico o una nota para el principal) para que los estudiantes de las escuelas primarias participen en esta huelga. No permitiremos que los estudiantes de primaria salgan de los salones sin este permiso. Los estudiantes de la escuela Media de Gurrie se pueden poner en contacto con el principal si no quieren que su hijo/a participe en esta huelga.**

Hemos pasado años trabajando con nuestros primeros respondedores para evaluar y mejorar continuamente nuestros planes y procedimientos de seguridad y protección. Tenemos Planes Integrales De Respuesta A Crisis que se desarrollaron con nuestros primeros respondedores en cada escuela. Revisamos estos planes anualmente con nuestros primeros respondedores que supervisan nuestros simulacros en toda la escuela para practicar estos planes. Además, nuestros primeros respondedores hacen un esfuerzo especial para ser visibles dentro y alrededor de nuestras escuelas, y están siempre disponibles para investigar cualquier asunto de seguridad. Nuestro distrito también continúa apoyándonos para mejorar la seguridad de nuestros edificios. Entradas aseguradas con cobertura de video fueron añadidas a todas las escuelas cuando remodelamos las escuelas en 2010-12. La cobertura de video también incluye áreas interiores comunes y todas las puertas exteriores. Nuestros primeros respondedores tienen acceso 24/7 a esta cobertura de video.

Tenga en cuenta que las relaciones afectuosas, respetuosas y de confianza que caracterizan a todas nuestras comunidades escolares siguen siendo nuestra mayor medida de seguridad. Nuestros estudiantes y familias saben que pueden comunicarse con adultos de confianza cuando ven o escuchan algo preocupante. Confían en que nuestro personal escolar investigará y abordará estas inquietudes de manera proactiva, a fondo y de manera profesional.

Dear Parents:

Just a reminder that this Friday, March 9, the entire 8th grade will travel to Navy Pier's Chicago Shakespeare Theatre to see the William Shakespeare play, *A Midsummer Night's Dream*. This activity is part of the Language Arts curriculum, and all students are expected to attend.

If you need assistance with providing a lunch, please contact your child's advisor or ELA teacher, and we will make arrangements for them.

Additionally, because we are going to the theatre, we like students to "dress up" on this day. Primarily we like to avoid the regular jeans, t-shirt and gym shoes ensemble, but please do not buy new clothes just for this. Students always represent Gurrie very well on field trips, and we expect this to be no exception.
