October 23rd -October 27th

Dear Parents,

Through the Red Ribbon campaign we hope to raise awareness of good decision making, the negative effects of alcohol and drug use, and to encourage children to make the choice to be drug-free. Red Ribbon Week activities have been developed by Teamwork 105 to be carried out during the week of October 23rd in all District 105 schools.

Monday, October 23rd

Each school will display their drug free school banner.

All students will receive a Red Ribbon Week pencil.

Our Pre-Kindergarten students will receive a Drug Free sticker/ribbon each day of the week.

Middle School: *Gurrie Gear Day – These Paws Don't Touch Drugs, Alcohol, and Tobacco.*

Tuesday, October 24th

Each classroom will receive a large ribbon that will be signed by students and teachers and displayed outdoors.

Elementary Buildings: *Team Up Tuesday- Students can wear their favorite team apparel to focus on teamwork/working together to say no to unhealthy choices.*

Middle School: *Twin Day: Let's work together to say no to drugs, alcohol, and tobacco.*

Wednesday, October 25th *Wear Red Day.*

Everyone should wear red. This day is observed nationally and will unite us with others observing Red Ribbon Week across the nation.

Thursday, October 26th

Elementary Buildings: *Use Your Head: Make Healthy Choices – Silly hair or hat day.*

Middle School: *Jump to the Future and Stay Away from Drugs and Alcohol. Wear your future college gear or dress as your future occupation.*

Friday, October 27th
