Dear Gurrie Families,

Over the past ten years, Gurrie's student population has grown considerably. As we continued to grow, we found that holding the graduation ceremony in the Gurrie gym became problematic. We could only issue limited tickets (today that would translate into roughly two tickets per family), there was no air conditioning, and the sheer number of people created an uncomfortable and difficult situation. We began to investigate other options and decided on the field house at Lyons Township High School, South Campus. This allowed the opportunity for air conditioning, families being able to attend without worries of tickets, and a sense of moving forward for our students as almost all of them would be attending LT as freshman. While many of us miss the friendly confines of Gurrie, this venue provides a positive and more comfortable graduation ceremony.

Each year, I have sent home information stating what our expectations for behavior at the ceremony is, and it is restated again that evening before students receive their diplomas. In the past, some people in the audience chose to ignore those expectations and mildly disrupted the ceremony with movement, allowing unsupervised children to move around the bleachers, and yelling and applauding loudly during the time when students' names were announced and diplomas awarded.

While we want everyone to be able to recognize the accomplishments of their child, grandchild, brother, sister or friend, it is vital that those in attendance follow our expectations for this distinguished ceremony, so that everyone can hear and enjoy their graduate's special moment.

We have discussed and investigated a variety of ideas to address our concerns and decided on the following expectations:

- all audience members, including children, are to stay seated with their family for the entire ceremony
 - standing and moving around blocks the view for other audience members
 - if you do not think that your children can sit through the hour or so program, please do not bring them to the graduation ceremony
- if you feel the need to bring balloons to the graduation, you will be asked to store them along the north wall of the Field House during the ceremony and you can pick them up on the way out of the building

- no one should get up and take pictures during the diploma distribution
 - please take pictures before or after the ceremony outside or in the commons
 - during the ceremony, you may take pictures while staying seated
 - do not approach the stage to get a picture
 - we will have a professional photographer on the stage taking pictures of each student as they receive their diplomas
- audience members will refrain from any behaviors that will detract from the dignity of the ceremony
 - please refrain from yelling, shouting, or other noises during the ceremony and in particular, when students names are read off to receive their diploma

We feel these expectations allow for a more respectful and enjoyable ceremony. Please contact me with any questions or concerns.

Estimadas Familias de Gurrie,

Durante los últimos diez años, el número de estudiantes de Gurrie ha crecido considerablemente. A medida que continuamos creciendo, hemos visto cómo problemático la celebración de la ceremonia de graduación en el gimnasio de Gurrie. Sólo podíamos expedir un número limitado de boletas (que se traduciría hoy en día a tan solo dos entradas por familia), no contábamos con aire acondicionado, y el gran número de personas creaba una situación incómoda y difícil. Empezamos a investigar otras opciones y optamos por las instalaciones atléticas de la sede sur de la Escuela Secundaria Lyons Township. Esto nos permite contar con aire acondicionado, permitir a las familias asistir sin preocupaciones de restricciones de boletas, y una sensación de continuidad para nuestros estudiantes ya que casi todos ellos estarán asistiendo a LT como estudiante de primer año de secundaria. Mientras que muchos de nosotros extrañamos los amistosos límites de Gurrie, este lugar proporciona un espacio positivo y más cómodo para la ceremonia de graduación.

Cada año, he enviado a las casas información indicando nuestras expectativas de comportamiento en la ceremonia, y se reafirman de nuevo esa noche antes de que los estudiantes reciban sus diplomas. En el pasado, algunas personas de la audiencia optaron por ignorar esas expectativas e interrumpieron ligeramente la ceremonia con sus movimientos, permitiendo a los niños moverse sin supervisión en las tribunas, gritando y aplaudiendo fuertemente durante el momento en que los nombres de los estudiantes son anunciados y durante la entrega de los diplomas.

Si bien queremos que todos puedan reconocer los logros de sus hijos, nietos, hermanos o amigos, es vital que los asistentes sigan nuestras expectativas para esta distinguida ceremonia, para que todos puedan escuchar y disfrutar el momento especial de su graduado.

Hemos discutido e investigado una variedad de ideas para manejar nuestras preocupaciones y hemos decidido fijar las siguientes expectativas:

- Todos los miembros del público, incluidos los niños, deben permanecer sentados con sus familias durante toda la ceremonia.
 - Ponerse de pie y estar moviéndose bloquea la vista de otros miembros del público.
 - Si usted piensa que sus niños no pueden permanecer sentados durante más o menos una hora de la duración del programa, por favor no los traiga a la ceremonia de graduación.

District 105 families,

During the course of this school year, District 105 schools were closed on three occasions due to severe weather. One of these days was made up when students attended school on January 18th. This day was originally a non-attendance day for students.

The Illinois School Code mandates a minimum of five **emergency days** for our school calendar. Emergency days may be used as school days if the school closes unexpectedly during the regular school year. These five days are identified on our annual D105 calendar every year, which is posted on the website (www.d105.net) under the calendar tab. This year, the Illinois State Board of Education is allowing school districts to substitute up to two student days for a full day of parent/teacher conferences and/or a full professional learning day for teacher. District 105 has both of these included in our calendar.

We have decided to extend the school year by one student day. Monday, June 3rd is scheduled as a half-day for student, but will now be a full day. In addition, students will also attend a full day of school on Tuesday. **The end of the 2018-2019 school year will be at 3:00 PM (3:15 PM for Gurrie) on Tuesday, June 4th.** The extension of the school year will add 1 ½ student days to the calendar for a total of 175 ½.

The updated district calendar will be posted to our D105 webpage.

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Familias del Distrito 105,

A lo largo de este año escolar, las escuelas del Distrito 105 se cerraron en tres ocasiones debido a un clima severo. Uno de estos días se compenso cuando los estudiantes asistieron a la escuela el 18 de enero. Esta fecha era originalmente un día en que los estudiantes no debían asistir a la escuela.

Un mandato del Código de las Escuelas de Illinois es que se incluya un mínimo de cinco **días de emergencia** en nuestro calendario escolar. Los días de emergencia se pueden usar como días de asistencia escolar, si la escuela se cierra inesperadamente durante un año regular de escuela. Estos cinco días están marcados en nuestro calendario anual del D105 todos los años, el cual está publicado en nuestra página electrónica (www.d105.net) bajo el folder llamado "calendar". Este año, La Junta Directiva de Educación del Estado de Illinois ha permitido a los distritos escolares que substituyan hasta dos días de asistencia de estudiantes por un día completo de conferencias entre padres y maestros, o un día completo de aprendizaje profesional para los maestros. El Distrito 105 ya tenía esos dos incluidos en nuestro calendario.

Hemos decidido extender el año escolar de los estudiantes un día adicional. El lunes 3 de junio esta designado como un día de asistencia por medio día solamente, pero ahora será un día completo. Además, los estudiantes también vendrán a la escuela un día completo el martes. **El final del año escolar 2018-2019 será a las 3:00 PM (3:15 PM para Gurrie) el martes, 4 de junio.** La extensión del año escolar añadirá 1 ½ días al calendario escolar, para un total de 175 ½ días de asistencia de los estudiantes.

El calendario actualizado estará publicado en nuestra página electrónica del D105.
