Beginning April 10, we will begin administering the PARCC (Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers) Performance Based Assessment.

This test assesses students on the Common Core English-Language Arts and Math standards. Students in seventh and eighth grade will be taking five assessments - two in reading, and three in math. Students will take the assessments using their Chromebooks. Testing takes place in the morning and will take place on April 10, 11, 17, and 18. After completing an assessment, students will follow an adjusted class schedule.

Students who are absent or tardy will need to make up the assessment(s) they missed during the testing window. It is very important that students are here and taking the assessments during the designated times.

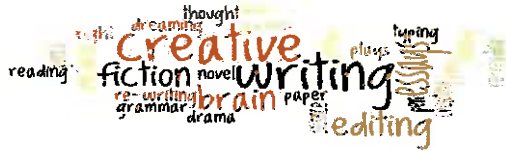

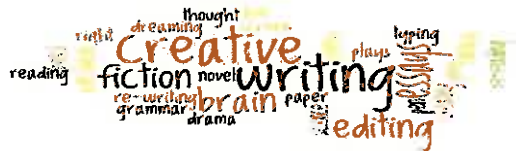
