Dear D105 Families,

Happy fall ... or I should say winter. It is the time of year when I send out our annual winter weather information to families. Of course my target date for the distribution of this letter was a few days late. As the forecast continues to change every day and it is very likely that more winter weather will be upon us soon, I would like to share information about weather related school closings.

The Lyons Township School Superintendents work together throughout the school year. During the winter months, this group communicates well before the start of the school day to monitor weather conditions and review other information provided by the police and bus companies. The group generally makes a decision together about whether or not to close the township schools unless there is an issue that affects only certain districts.

If District 105 schools are closed, radio & TV stations that broadcast school closings will be notified as early as possible. These stations include: WGN, 720 AM; WBBM, 780 AM; CBS 2 TV; NBC 5 TV; ABC 7 TV; WGN 9 TV; FOX 32 TV; and CLTV. We also provide information through the following sources about District 105 school closings and other weather-related circumstances such as late buses:

- The district's website, www.d105.net, is your best source for timely information about whether our schools are closed or in session on days with emergency weather situations.
- The district will also update our social media site with the most current updates regarding school closings and/or modifications to our schedule.

 - Instagram – lagrange105
- Parents can also find any changes in our schedule by visiting www.emergencyclosingcenter.com.
- Please do not call your school or the district office about school closing information as our personnel will be very busy responding to the safety needs that arise during emergency weather.

In addition to providing information through the sources listed above, **we will contact parents/guardians about school closings and other weather-related circumstances with our automated message service, which makes phone calls to cell and home phones numbers.** Emails with the voice messages embedded and text messages (for those who have "opted in") will be sent to parents/guardians as well. If you have changed your phone number or email address since registration, please contact your school office to update your contact information. Finally, if you would like text messages, but you have not yet "opted in," please send a text message of "Y" or "Yes" to our district's short code 67587.

NEW INFORMATION: For the first time, all Lyons Township districts, including District 105, have developed an optional LATE ARRIVAL. This option may be utilized this year for all five D105 schools as an alternative to cancelling school during severe weather conditions. If D105 chooses to implement a late



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arrival, our school day will begin at 10:00 AM, and we will notify our parents in the same manner we use for the cancellation of school. Attached to this letter are LATE ARRIVAL bus stop times alongside our regular bus stop schedules. The schedules can also be found under the PARENT/GUARDIAN tab of our District 105 website and each individual school website.

Please be assured that the safety of our students is foremost in my mind when I make a decision with the township superintendents concerning the cancellation of school. Because individual circumstances vary, it is important to recognize that our parents have the primary right and responsibility to determine whether or not to send their children to school during emergency weather situations.

Queridas Familias del D105,

Feliz ~~otoño~~ ... o debo decir invierno. Esta es la época del año en la que envío nuestra información anual sobre el clima de invierno a las familias. Por supuesto, mi fecha meta para la distribución de esta carta era unos días más tarde. Como el pronóstico sigue cambiando cada día y es muy probable que pronto tengamos más clima de invierno sobre nosotros, me gustaría compartir información sobre los cierres de las escuelas relacionadas con el clima.

Los Superintendentes de los distritos de Lyons Township trabajan juntos durante todo el año escolar. Durante los meses de invierno, este grupo se comunica antes del inicio del día escolar, para monitorear las condiciones climáticas y revisar otra información proporcionada por la policía y las compañías de camiones escolares. El grupo generalmente toma una decisión juntos sobre si deben cerrar o no las escuelas de la región a menos que haya un problema que afecte sólo a ciertos distritos.

Si las escuelas del Distrito 105 se cierran, las estaciones de radio y televisión que transmiten los cierres escolares serán notificadas tan pronto como sea posible. Estas estaciones incluyen: WGN, 720 AM; WBBM, 780 AM; CBS 2 TV; NBC 5 TV; ABC 7 TV; WGN 9 TV; FOX 32 TV; y CLTV. Nosotros también proporcionamos información a través de las siguientes fuentes sobre los cierres de escuelas del Distrito 105 y otras circunstancias relacionadas con el clima, como camiones escolares tarde:

- La página web del distrito, www.d105.net, es su mejor fuente para obtener información a tiempo sobre si nuestras escuelas están cerradas o en sesión en días con situaciones climáticas de emergencia.
- El distrito también actualizará nuestro sitio de redes sociales con las actualizaciones más recientes con respecto a los cierres de escuelas y/o modificaciones a nuestro horario.

 - Los padres también pueden encontrar cualquier cambio en nuestro horario visitando www.emergencyclosingcenter.com.

Por favor, no llame a su escuela o a la oficina del distrito sobre la información de cierre de la escuela, puesto que nuestro personal estará muy ocupado respondiendo a las necesidades de seguridad que surgen durante emergencias del clima.

Adicionalmente a suministrar información a través de las fuentes listadas arriba, **nosotros contactaremos a padres/guardianes sobre los cierres de escuelas y otras circunstancias relacionadas, por medio de nuestro Servicio de Mensajería Automatizado, el cual hace llamadas telefónicas a números celulares y teléfonos de casa.** También enviaremos correos electrónicos con mensajes de voz incluidos y mensajes de texto (para aquellos que “lo han optado”) a padres/guardianes. Si usted ha



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cambiado su número de teléfono o la dirección de correo electrónico desde la registración, por favor contacte la oficina de su escuela para actualizar su información de contacto. Finalmente, si a usted le gustaría recibir mensajes de texto, pero aún no "lo ha optado" por favor envíe un mensaje texto a nuestro distrito código corto 67587, escribiendo "Y" o "Yes".

INFORMACION NUEVA: Por primera vez, todos los distritos de Lyons Township, incluyendo el Distrito 105, han desarrollado una opción de LLEGADA TARDE. Esta opción se puede utilizar este año para las cinco escuelas del D105 como una alternativa a cancelar la escuela durante condiciones climáticas severas. Si el D105 decide implementar la llegada tarde, nuestro día escolar empezará a las 10:00 AM, y notificaremos a nuestros padres de la misma manera que lo hicimos para la cancelación de la escuela. A esta carta se adjuntan los horarios de las paradas del camión escolar para la LLEGADA TARDE, junto con nuestros horarios regulares de paradas del camión escolar. Los horarios también están en el folder PADRE/GUARDIAN de nuestra página web del Distrito 105 y en la página individual de cada escuela.

Quiero afirmar que la seguridad de nuestros estudiantes es lo más importante en mi mente cuando tome una decisión con los superintendentes del municipio con respecto a la cancelación de la escuela. Debido a que las circunstancias individuales varían, es importante reconocer que nuestros padres tienen el derecho y la responsabilidad principal de determinar si envían o no a sus niños a la escuela durante situaciones climáticas de emergencia.

Gurrie Families,

On Tuesday, November 26, Gurrie will be celebrating our 22nd annual Feast. Each advisory will be planning and enjoying a meal together with all our other advisories. Your child will be asked to bring an item. This can be any type of food that your family eats during their own Thanksgiving celebration-an entrée, a salad, a vegetable, a casserole, a bread item, a potato dish, or a dessert.

Advisors will be talking with students about the meal, items to bring, and what will be needed. We will send home information in the next few weeks with the items your child has offered to bring in.

This food item should be brought to school on the morning of The Feast. It **should be labeled** with the student's name and advisory as well as any specific information for reheating and serving. 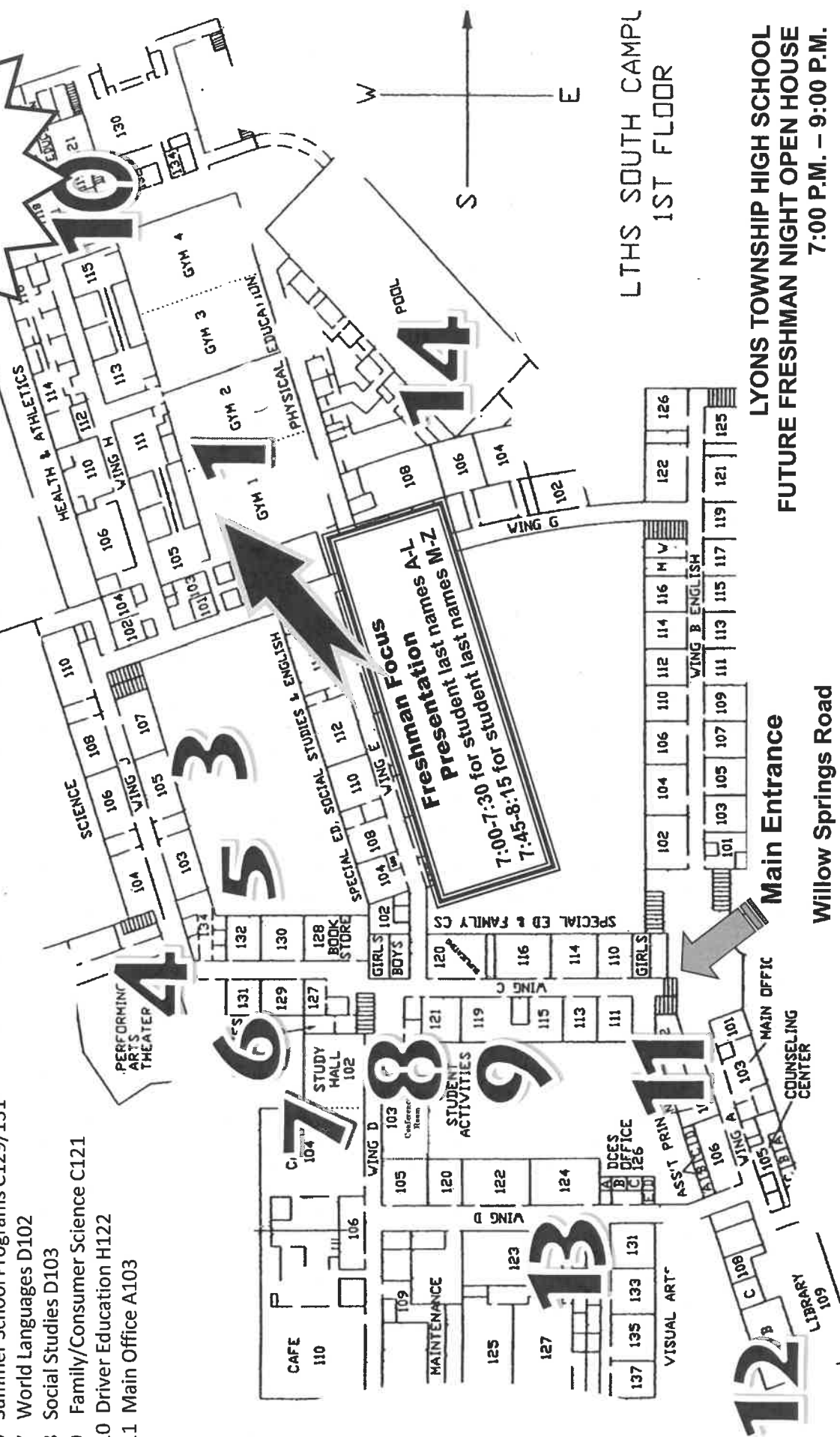

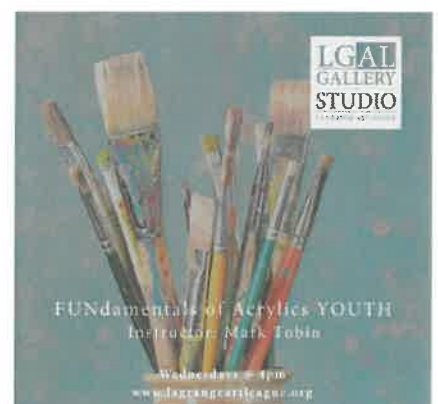
