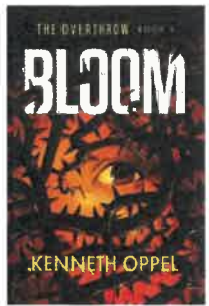

District 105 Preschool Screening Wednesday, May 5, 2021

School District #105 will be conducting preschool screening for **three to five year old children** residing in the district. The screening team will assess each child's development to determine who might benefit from special services prior to Kindergarten. The following skill areas will be assessed:

1. Concepts-body parts, colors, rapid object naming, rote counting(counting forward, counting backward, number identification), meaningful counting(counting blocks, number relationships), shapes(identifying shapes, sorting shapes, sorting by color and size)
2. Speech and Language-personal information, articulation, identifying objects and actions (expressively and receptively), letters and sounds(alphabet song, letter naming, letter-sound correspondence), problem-solving
3. Vision and Hearing

Screening will take place **Wednesday, May 5th between 8:30 AM and 2:00 PM** at **Hodgkins School 6516 Kane Ave, Hodgkins** for all district children. The entire screening will take about 60 minutes.

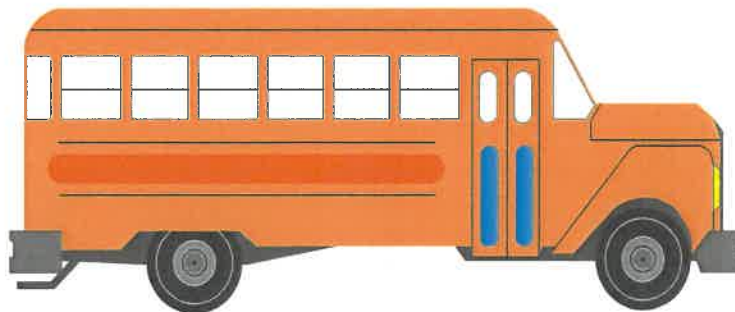
Please call the District Office at 708-482-2760 to schedule an appointment.

El equipo de especialistas evaluará el desarrollo de su hijo/a, para determinar si su niño/a, puede beneficiarse de los servicios especiales, antes de que entre al Kínder. Los niño/as, serán evaluados en las siguientes áreas:

1. Conceptos- nombrar las partes del cuerpo, los colores, nombrar objetos con rapidez, contar en orden, contar los números de mayor a menor, identificar los números, contar bloques y relacionarlos con el número, las figuras geométricas básicas, y separar las figuras geométricas por su color y tamaño.
2. Lenguaje y el Habla- información personal, articulación, identificar objetos y sus acciones, (expresivo y receptivo), letras y sus sonidos (la canción del abecedario) y resolver problemas.
3. Examen de Ojos y Oídos

La evaluación tomara lugar miércoles, 5 de mayo de las 8:30 AM a las 2:00 PM. en el Hodgkins School, 6516 Kane Ave. Hodgkins. Esta es para los niño/as, del Distrito #105. La evaluación dura 60 minutos.
