Hello eighth grade families.

Our graduation ceremony is rapidly approaching. Visit our website www.d105.net/gurrie, scroll down to the graduation section where you will find all the communication that we have sent home regarding the end of the year. If you have not already, please review.

- At the end of the day on Thursday, May 23 students will receive their graduation gown and tickets (5) for the ceremony. They will sign for these items. Please check in with them that evening to make sure everything got home ok. We do not have extra gowns or tickets.
- On Friday, May 24 at the beginning of the day, 8th grade students will report to their advisory. They will then turn in their Chromebook, charger, and if they utilize one, a hotspot. Please remember that there is not an option to purchase used Chromebooks this year by graduating 8th grade students. They will then head to Great America. If your student chooses not to attend Great America or is not eligible to attend, there will be a schedule for them here at Gurrie that day.
- If your student has an outstanding fee (gown / medallion, library fine, Chromebook fee) please be sure to send that to school no later than Friday, May 24. Thank you for your attention to this.
- On Tuesday May 28, students will report at the normal time to school. They will then participate in activities that include graduation practice and will be dismissed at approximately 11:30/12pm. There will be bus service available.
- Students should report to the ceremony no later than 4:30 that evening, in their graduation gown. Students will be lined up and prepared to walk into the ceremony at 5pm. Doors open for seating at 4:30 and seating is available on a first come, first serve basis.
- At the end of the ceremony, we will dismiss graduates and they will recess out of the building. The ceremony is approximately one hour.
