E & P: What were your strategies to win the 6A state championship?


Coach: We knew we had a great team to start out with so we had to stay healthy and play a lot of play-

Lindsey Stirling inspired me to play the violin. That is Lindsey Stirling!



- To empty a raw egg, you need a long, sharp needle and a plastic straw (the type with a bend in it).
- Poke a hole slightly larger than the end of the straw in one end of the egg and remove the bits of shell.
- Insert the pin through the hole and stir the inside of the egg to break the yolk up a bit.
- ♦ Hold the end of the egg with the hole over a bowl.
- ♦ Then insert the straw into the hole

- and blow into the other end to force air into the eggshell, which will cause the yolk to come out the same hole you're blowing into, which is why you should make the hole bigger than your straw.
- ♦ Rinse the empty shell and let it dry.

Egg Dying

♦ In a small bowl or cup mix together ½ cup boiling water, 1 teaspoon white vinegar, and 5-10 drops of

- food coloring.
- Put egg into dye, and turn occasionally to be sure the egg is evenly coated.
- When the egg is the color you want it to be, remove it from the cup and place it on a paper

towel.

Invasive Species and the Impact on the Environment

What is an invasive species?

An invasive species is an animal, plant, or insect that starts to get into other habitats where they are not native. An invasive species can also spread VERY quickly. They out compete other native species in the course of their survival and they take over and cause damage. They can go to other places because humans accidentally bring them over from other places or countries.

How can climate change help invasive species take over?

The longer growing seasons, caused by climate change, are helping invasive plants. Extended springs mean they can more quickly push aside native species and transform ecosystems. Invasive plants come up first in the spring, so the longer season gives them more time to grow and shade out native plants. They invade other habitats where they are not native to out compete the other plants for survival. Those are some ways an invasive species can harm other habitats.

Animals

Some invasive species are animals. One example of an invasive species that lives in the water is the zebra mussel. Zebra mussels have spread from Europe to the Great Lakes by attaching to ships in Europe and coming off when the ships get to the great lakes. Zebra mussels are causing the people in the United States to spend lots of money on the damage they create. Since zebra mussels can attach to objects easily they can attach to pipes and boat motors. clogging them up. Then people need to pay for the damage caused by the zebra mussels. Zebra mussels affect humans, and also other animals. Zebra mussels can attach themselves to Native mussels killing them. Zebra mussels are taking the food small fish need to grow up into bigger fish.

The Asian carp are another invasive species. There are four varieties of Asian carp: bighead, grass, black, and silver. Asian carp can affect both humans and other animals. They can

jump very high when disturbed and sometimes injure people in boats. Asian carp affect fish by eating too much plant and animal plankton. Bighead and silver carp can eat from 5-20 percent of their body weight each day. Eating so much food doesn't leave enough food for native species and these other fish slowly die. Asian carp reaching the Great Lakes would cause lots of problems.

Invasive Plants

Another type of invasive species is plants. Some invasive plants are the garlic mustard plant or the buckthorn. The plant garlic mustard came here from Europe on purpose to be an edible plant but began to grow everywhere. This plant is an invasive species because it spreads into woodlands and forests. The plant also takes up the food, light, and water needed by native plants and without these things the plants are starting to die.







Leeches




