May 4th Gurrie





"It was amazing to see you again May. I love you, and I am so sorry about our uncle, he is not a good person." Milo said.


"I love you too Milo." I said, after a few moments of silence.


And Milo and I stared at each other, knowing that this was the end. "Goodbye May." Milo said.


