School District 105 General Music Goals—5th Grade

Illinois Music Standard 25A: Students will understand the sensory elements, organizational principles and expressive qualities of the arts.

5th Grade Learning Goals

- The students will be able to label music notation in a written work.
- The students will be able to identify syncopation in a musical example.
- The students will be able to distinguish major and minor tonality.
- The students will be able to define common Italian musical terms (e.g. tempos, dynamics, articulations).
- The students will be able to express a mood, emotion or original musical idea in a composition.
- The students will be able to compare and contrast expressive qualities in two performances.

- The students will be able to analyze how artistic components combined within a work of art.

- The students will be able to describe the roles of the performers in a concert.
