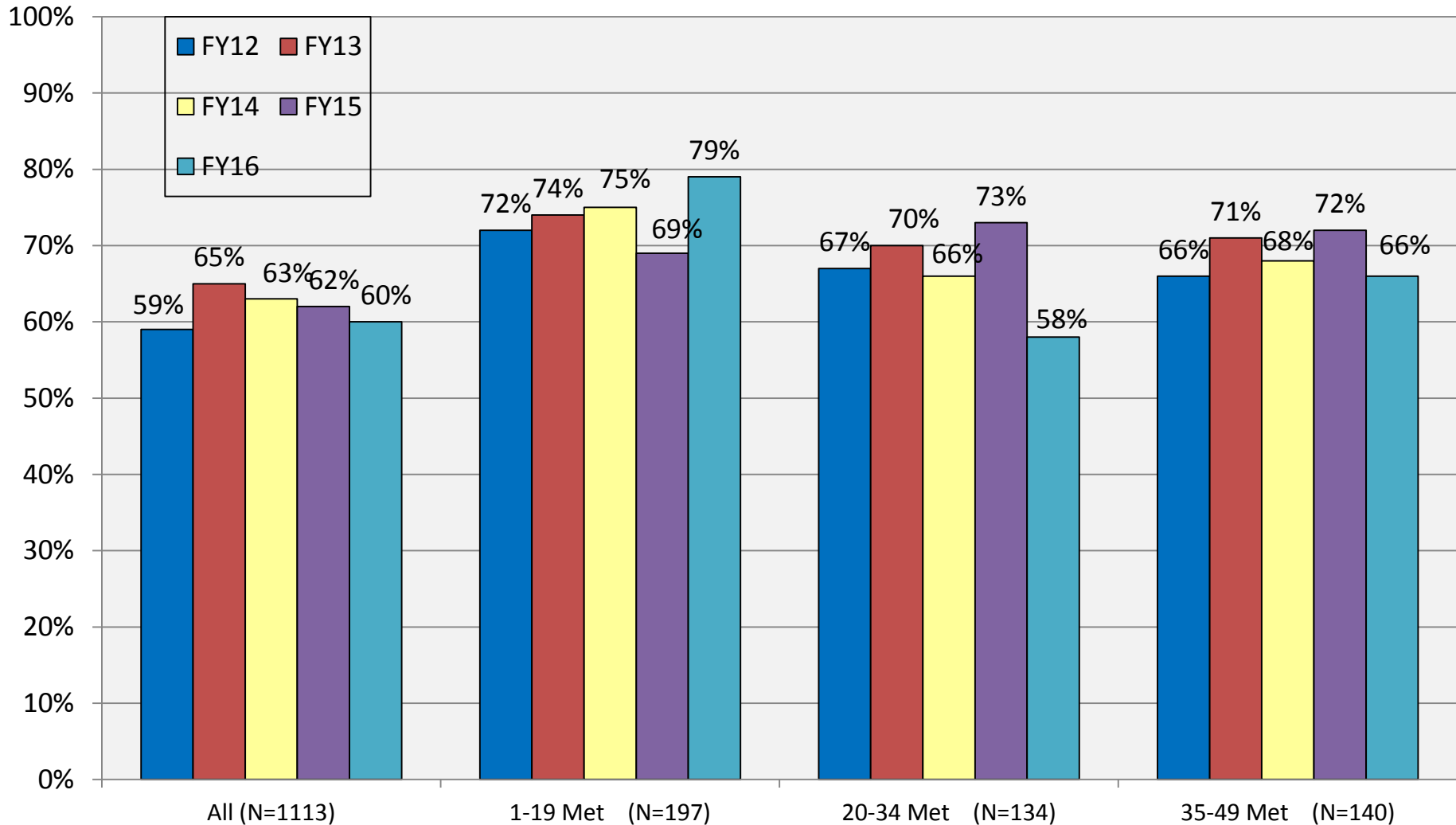

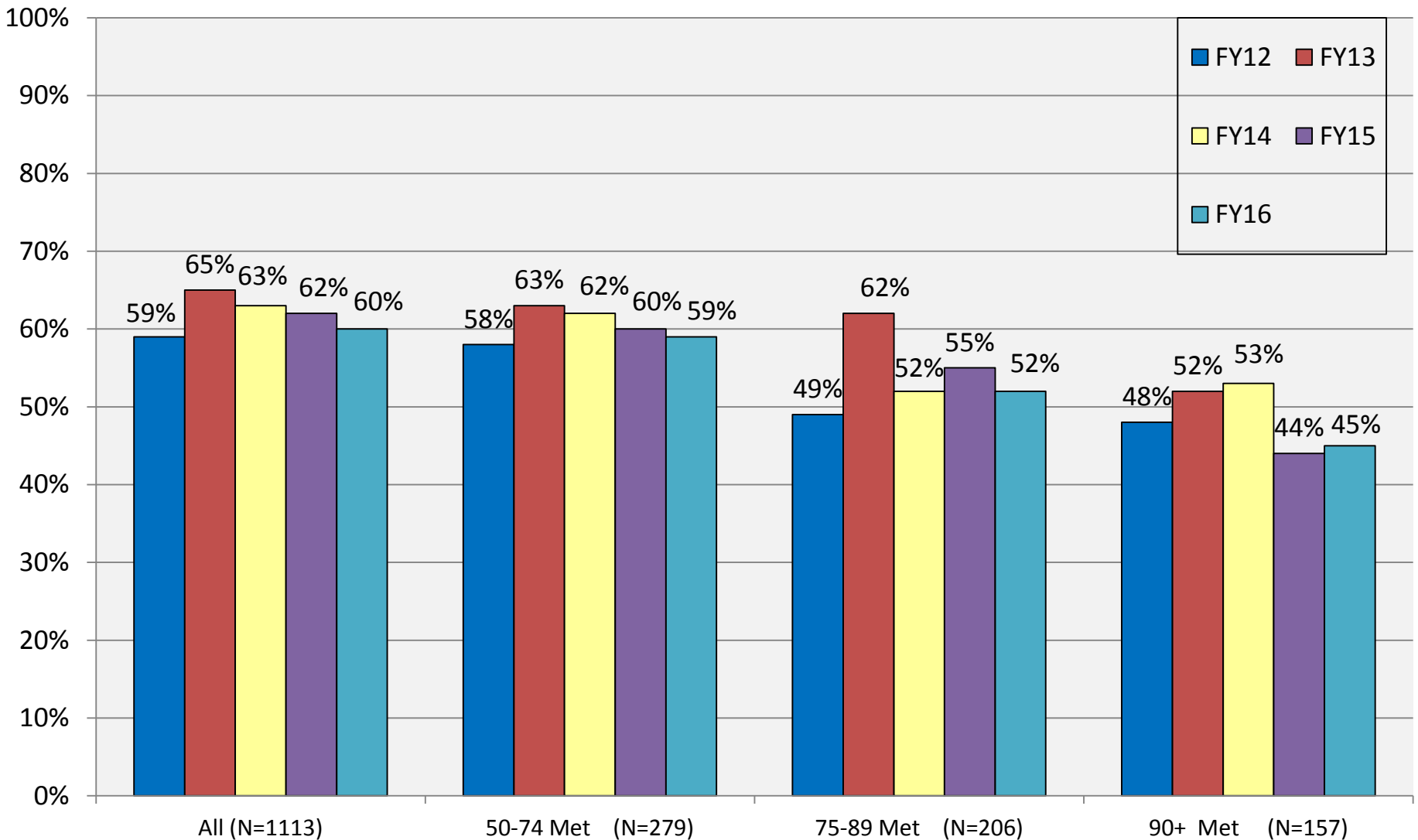
District 105 Reading Progress Fall-Spring FY16

in Each Percentile Range*



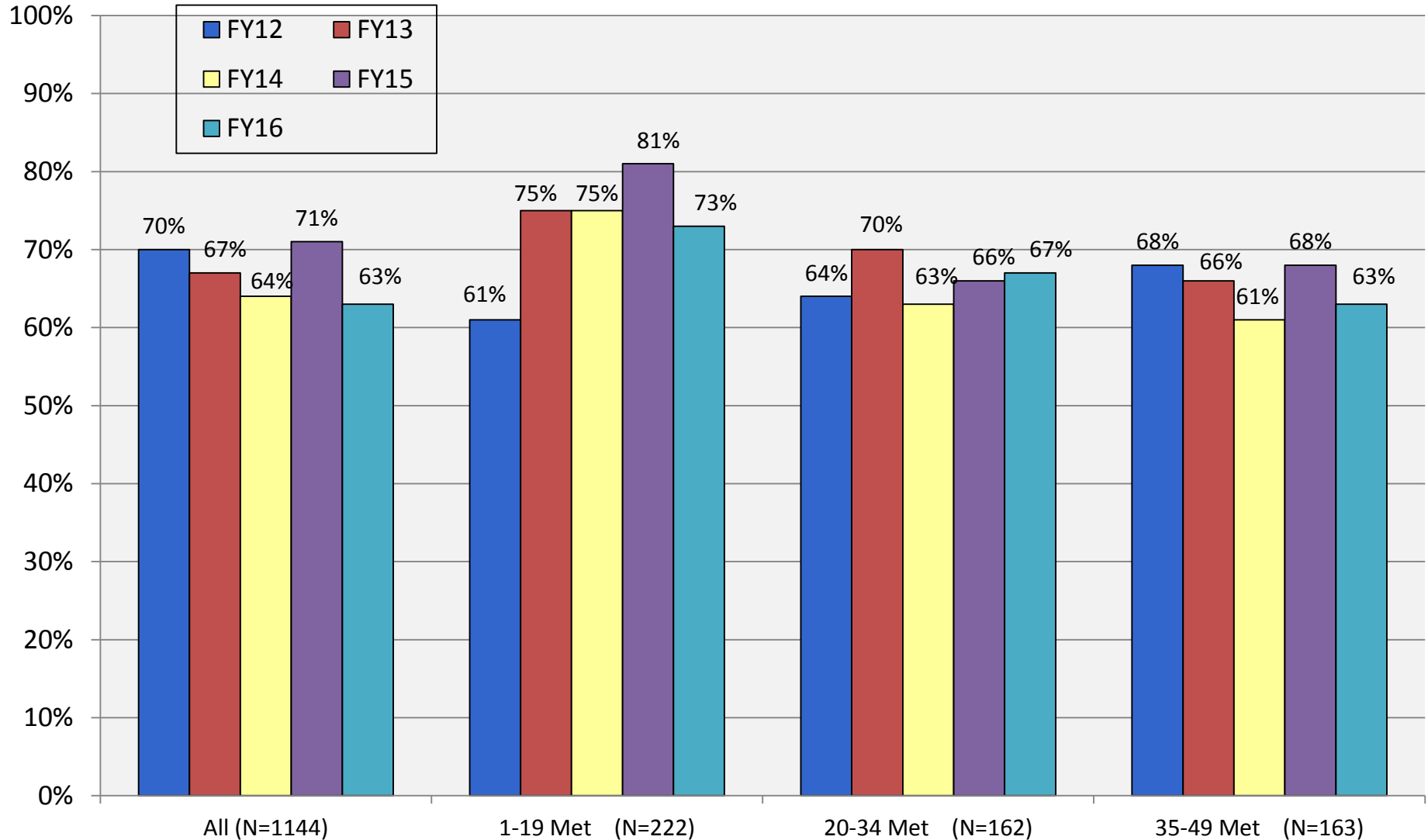

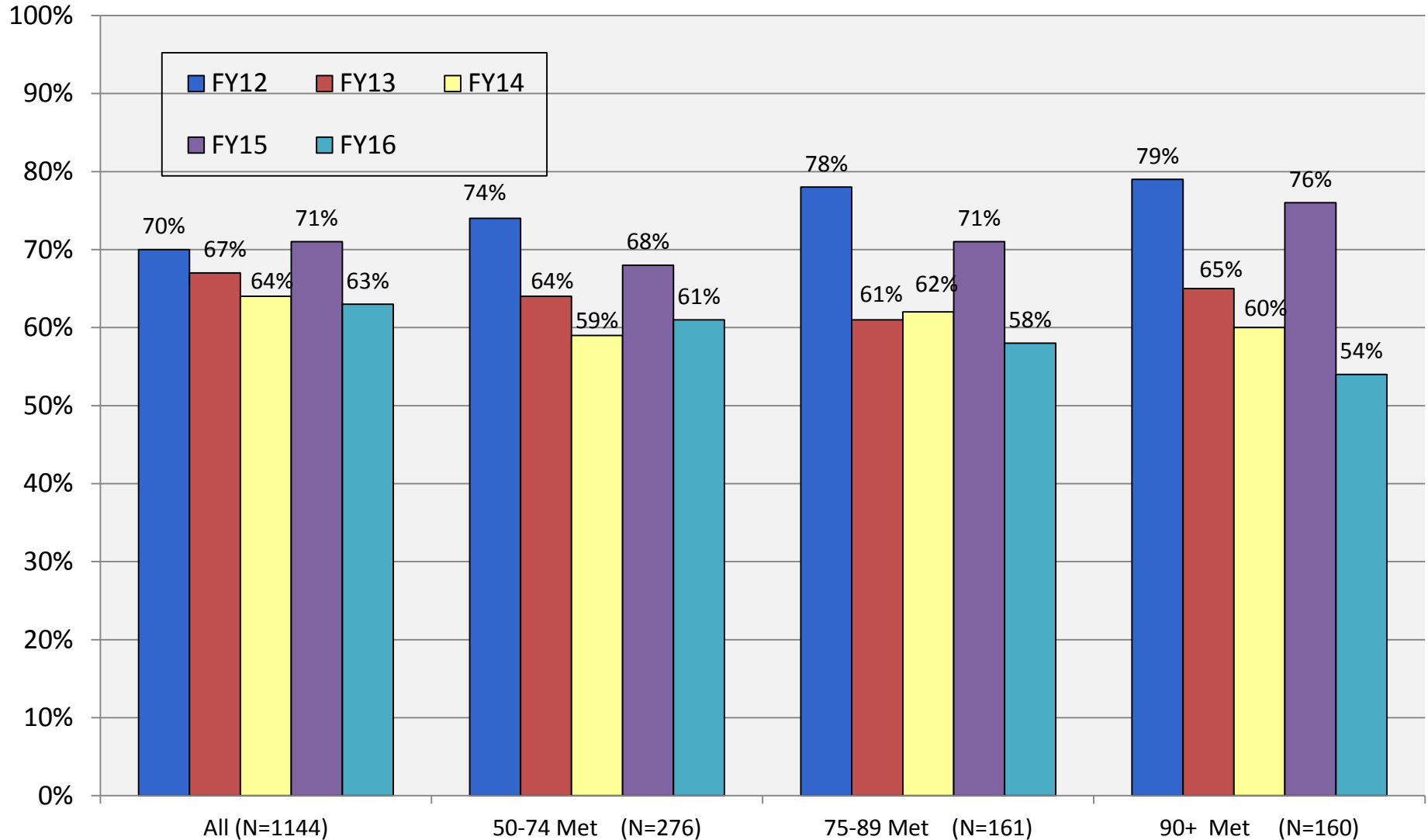


District 105 Math Progress Fall-Spring FY16

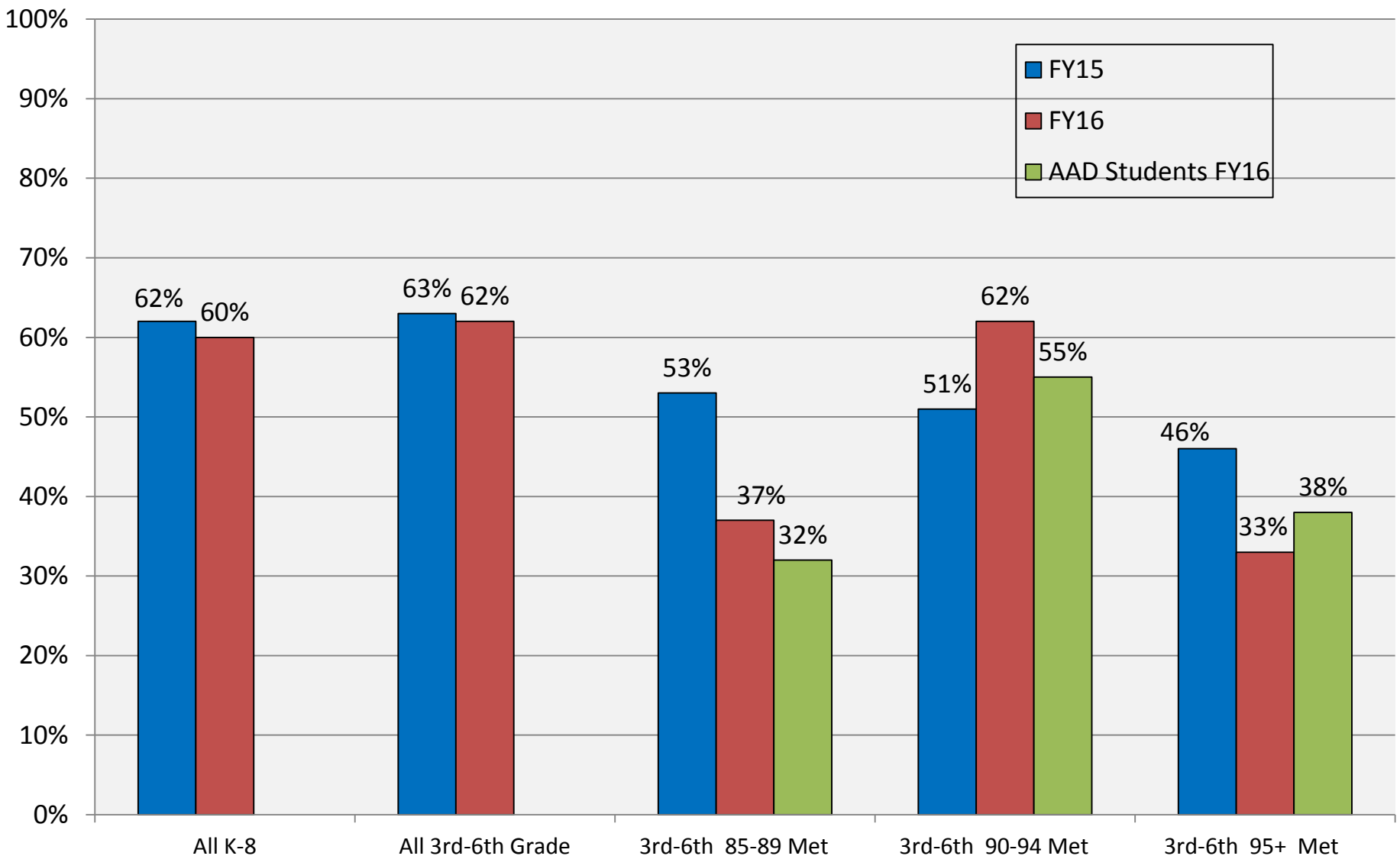

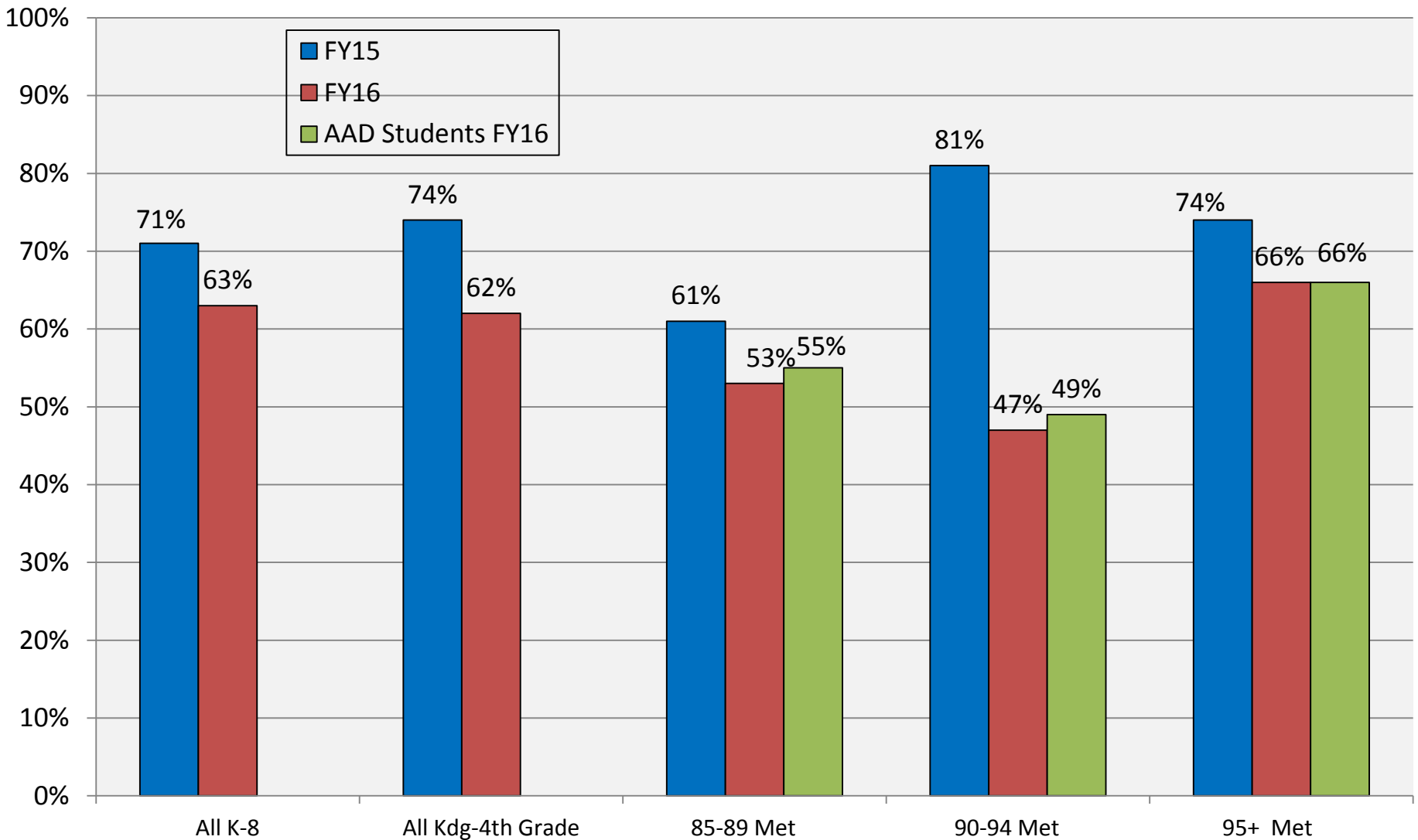

Each Percentile Range

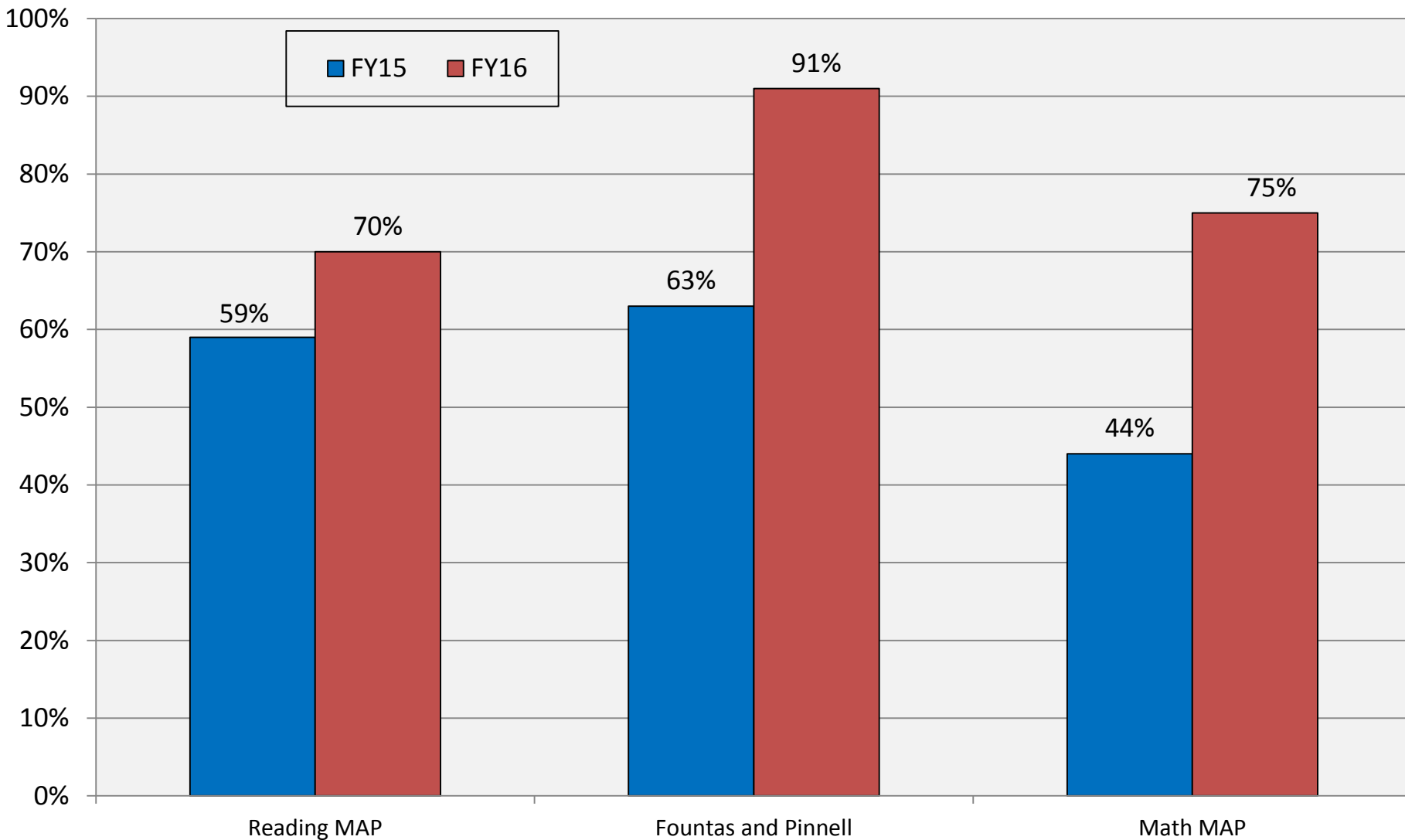

Percentage of Students At or Above Grade Level in Reading and Math

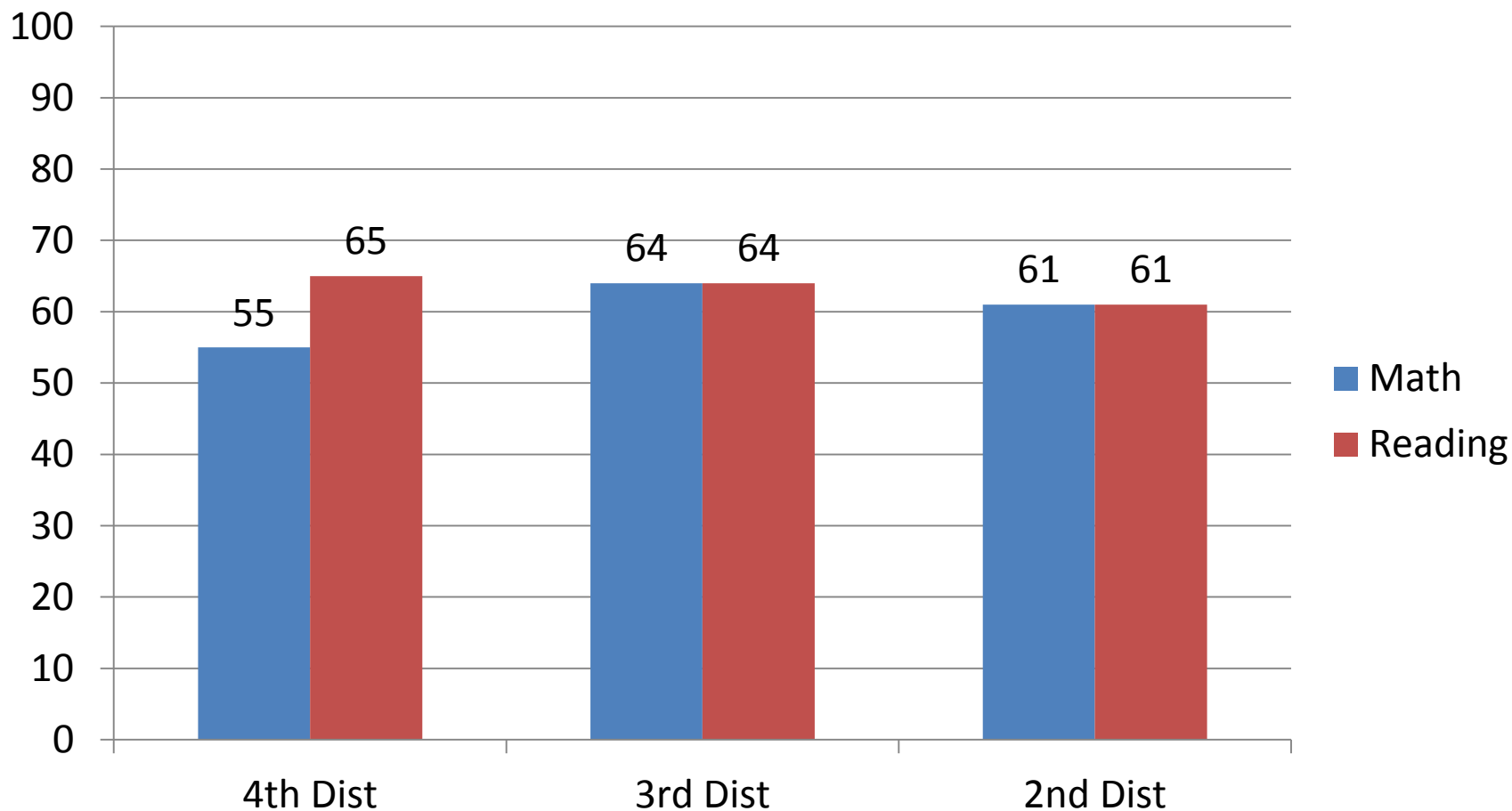

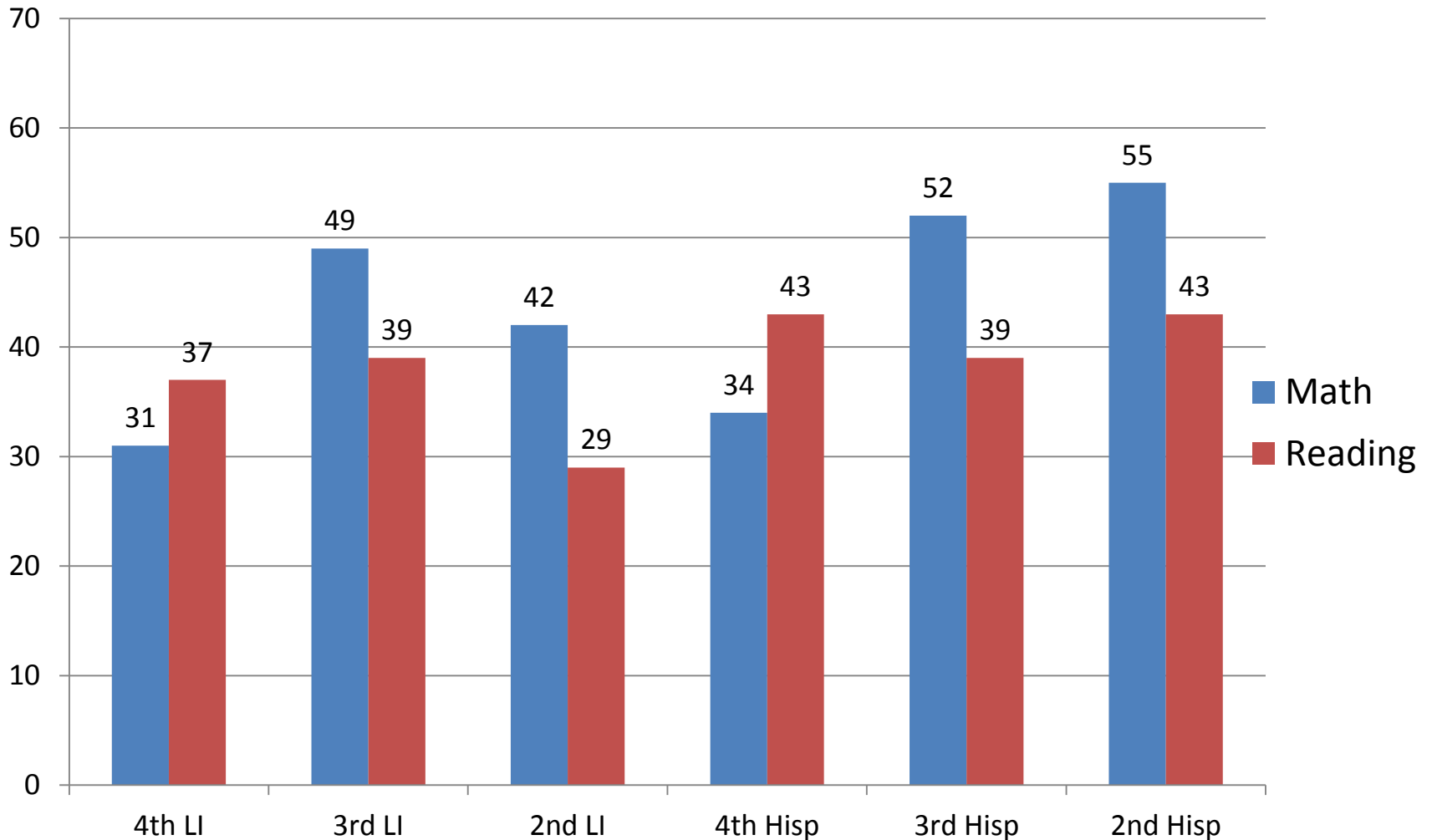

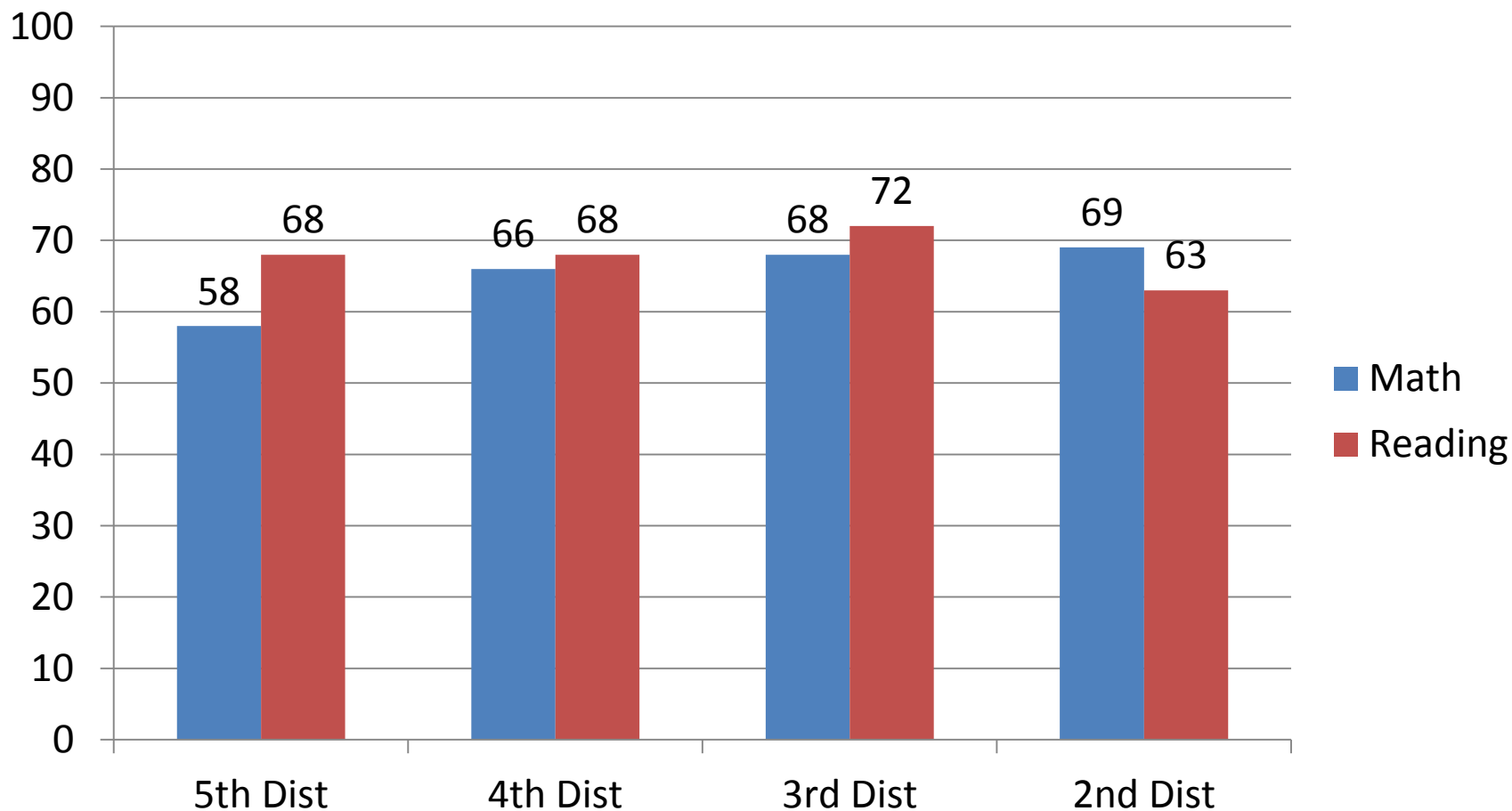
District 4th Grade Cohort - Percentage of students at or above 50th percentile n=112



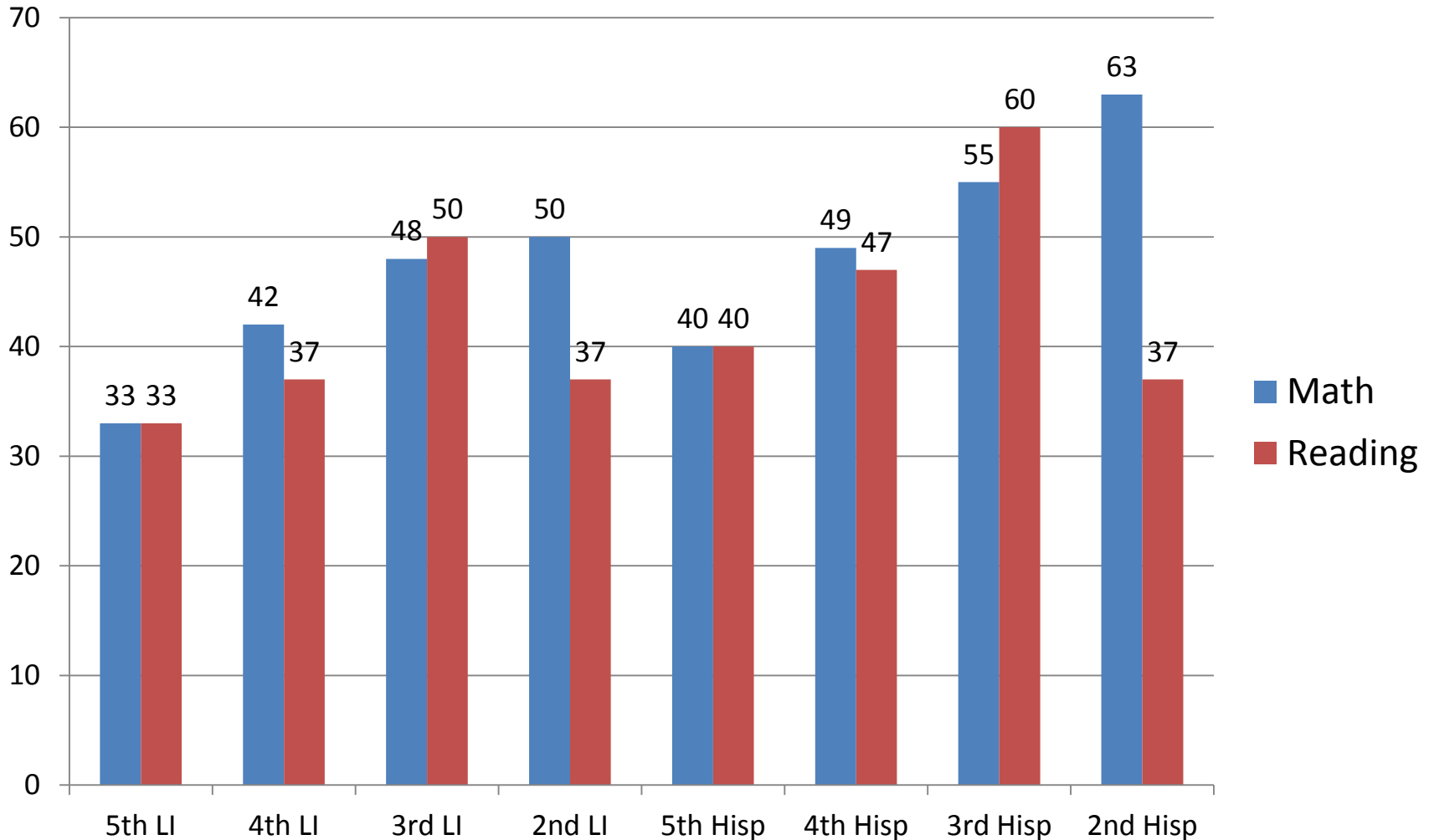
4th Grade Low Income (51) and Hispanic (40) Cohorts –
Percentage at or above the 50th percentile on spring MAP.



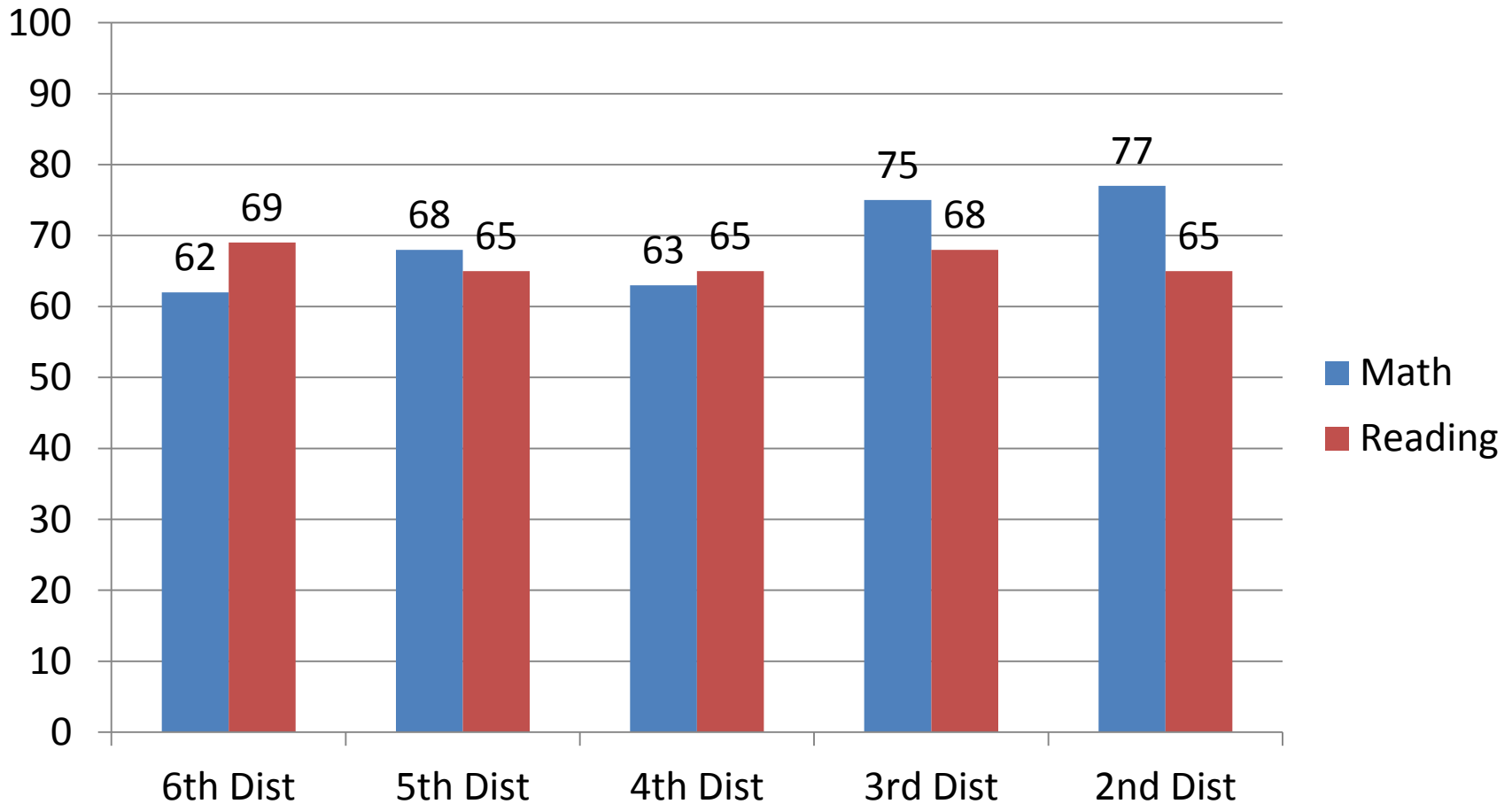
District 5th Grade Cohort - Percentage of students at or above 50th percentile n=113



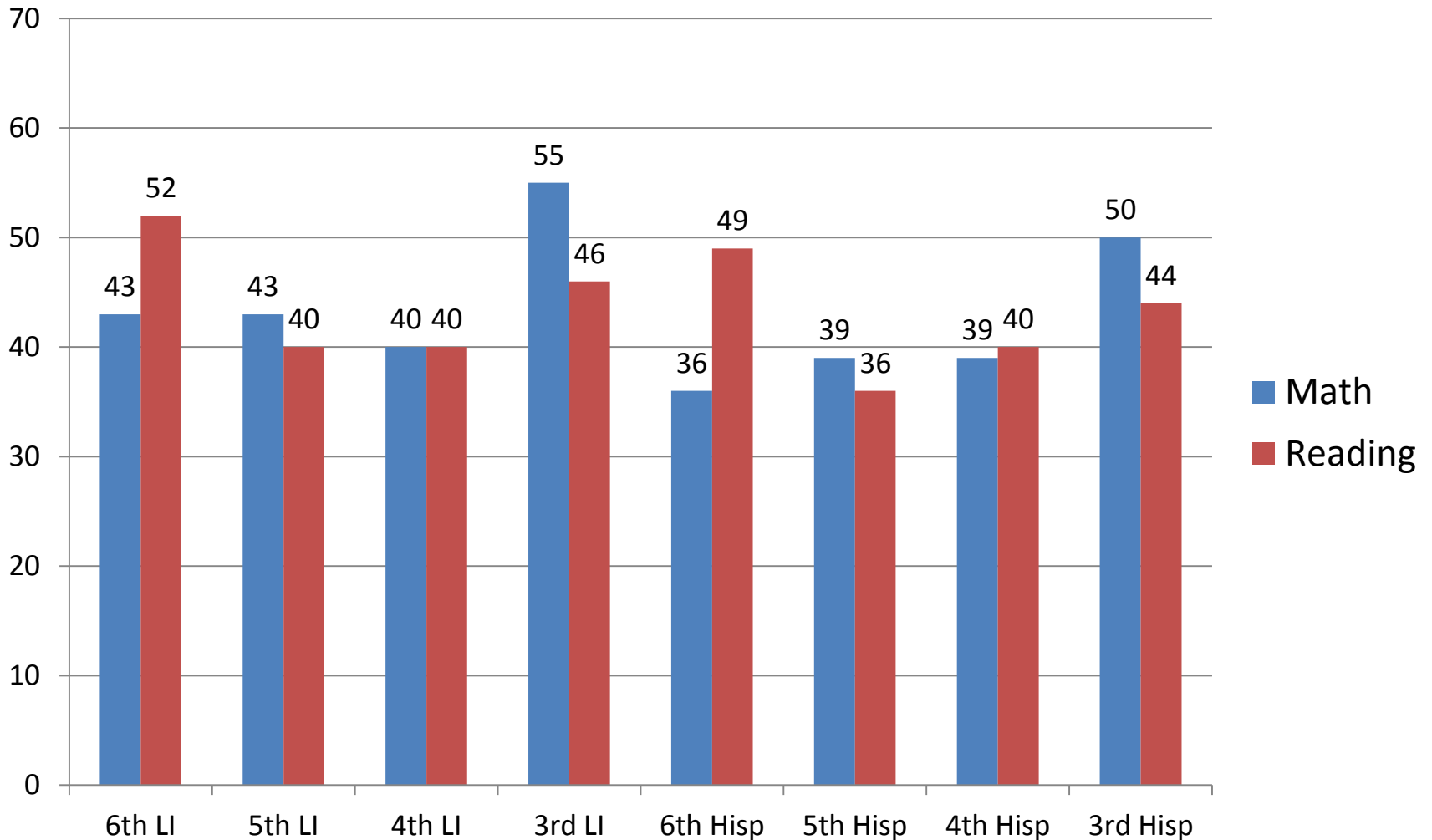
5th Grade Low Income (48) and Hispanic (47) Cohorts – Percentage at or above the 50th percentile on spring MAP.



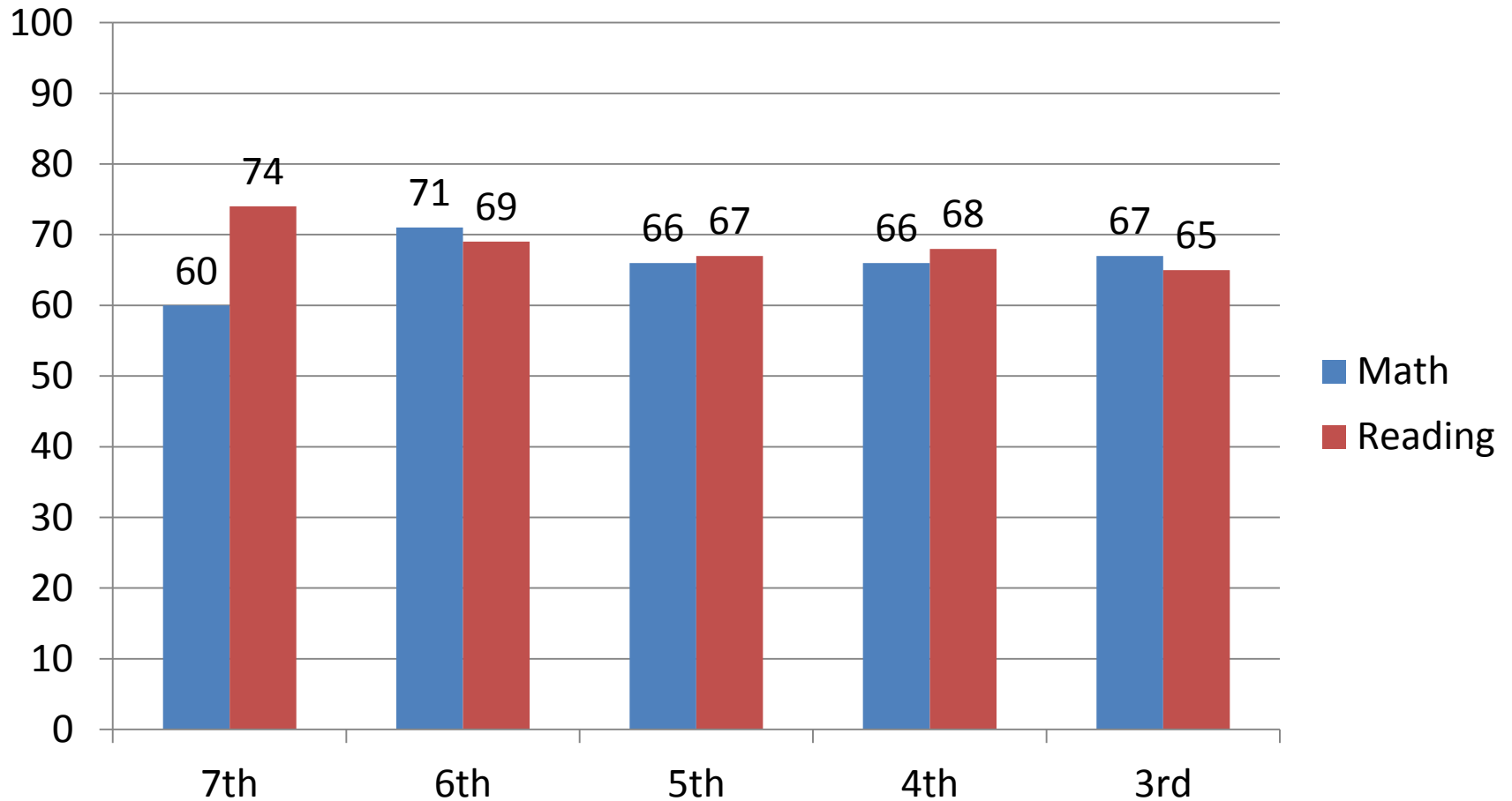
District 6th Grade Cohort Percentage of students at or above 50th percentile n=88



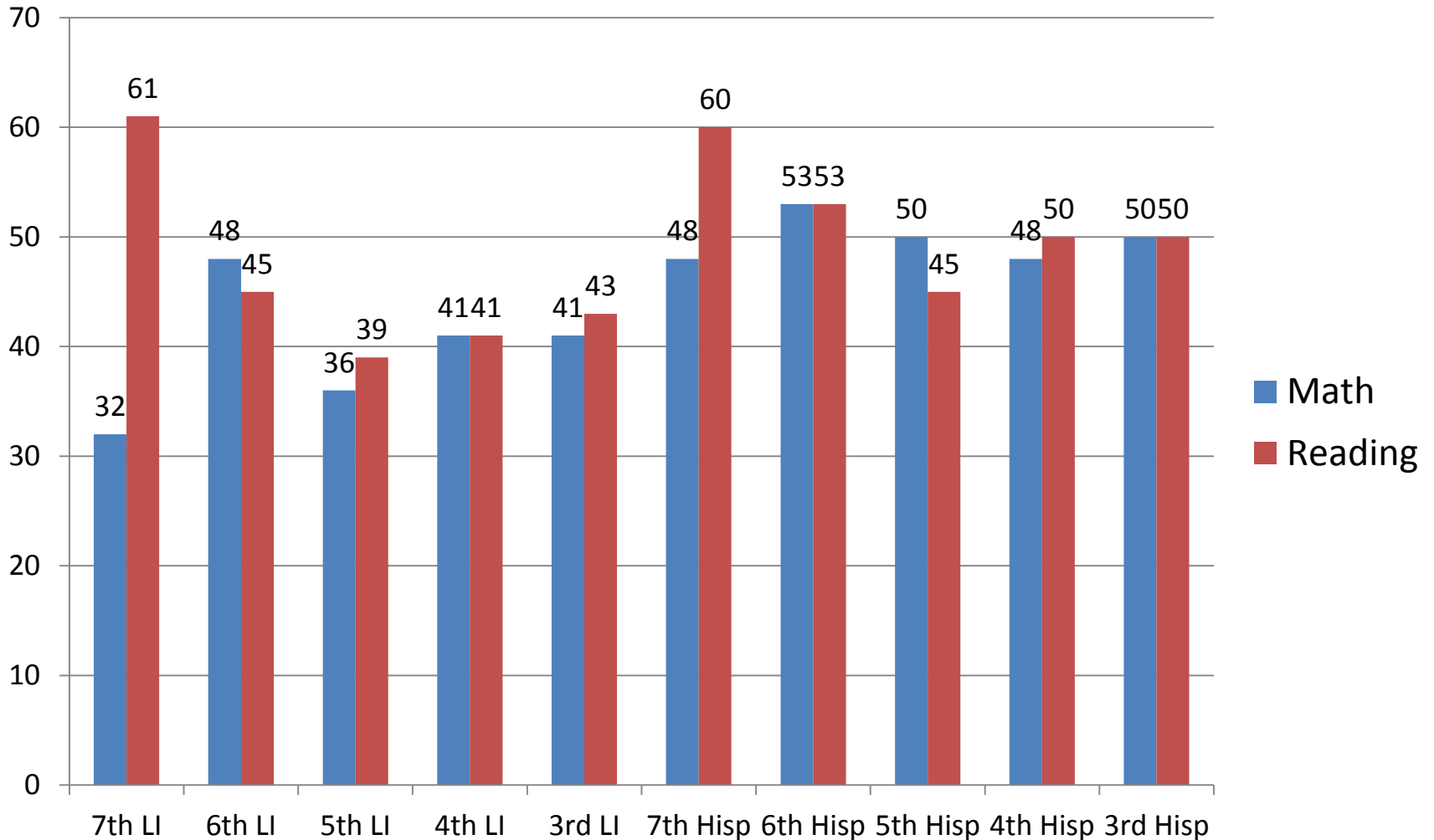
6th Grade Low Income (47) and Hispanic (44) Cohorts – Percentage at or above the 50th percentile on spring MAP.



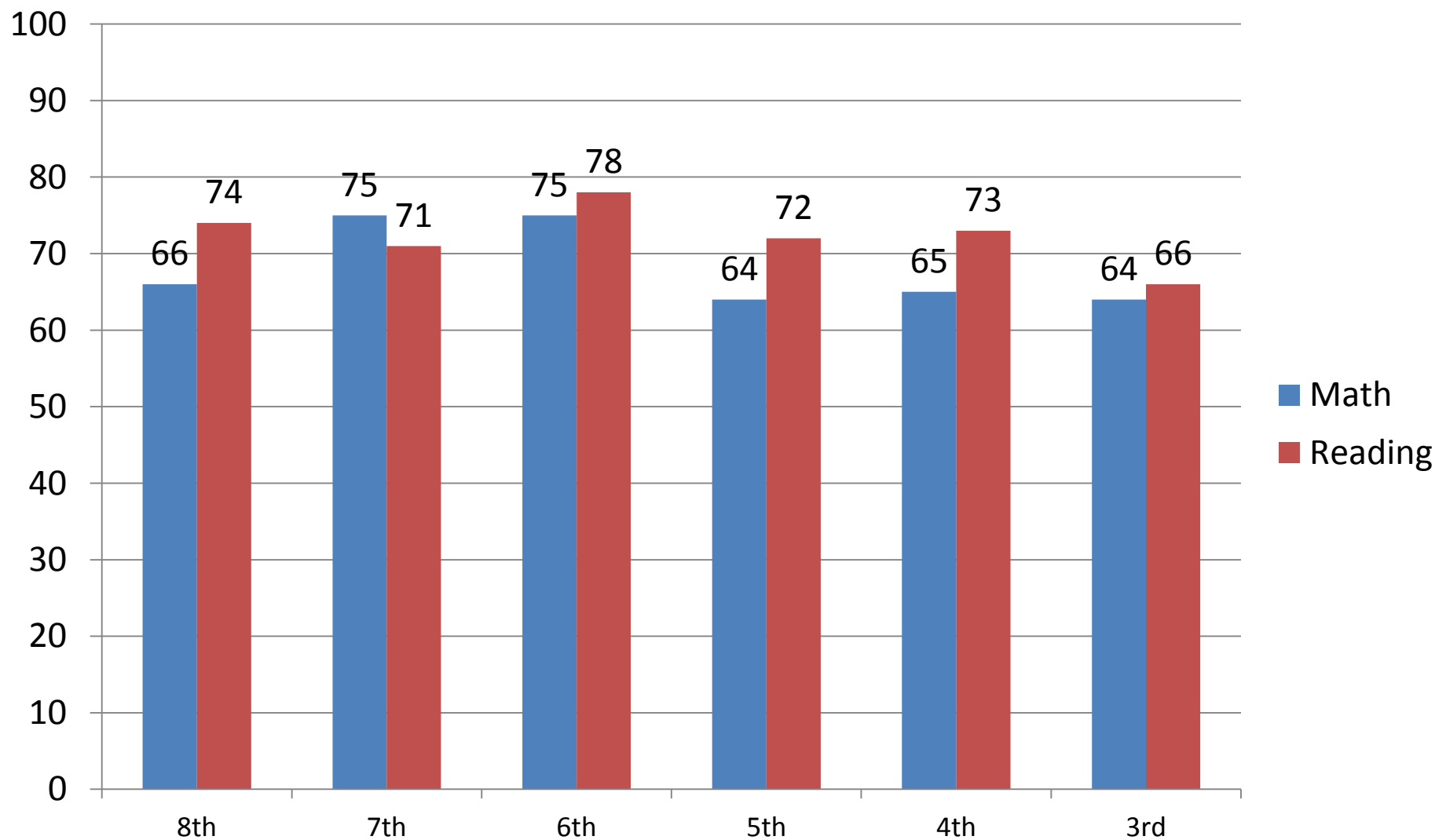
District 7th Grade Cohort – Percentage of students at or above the 50th percentile on spring MAP. N=117



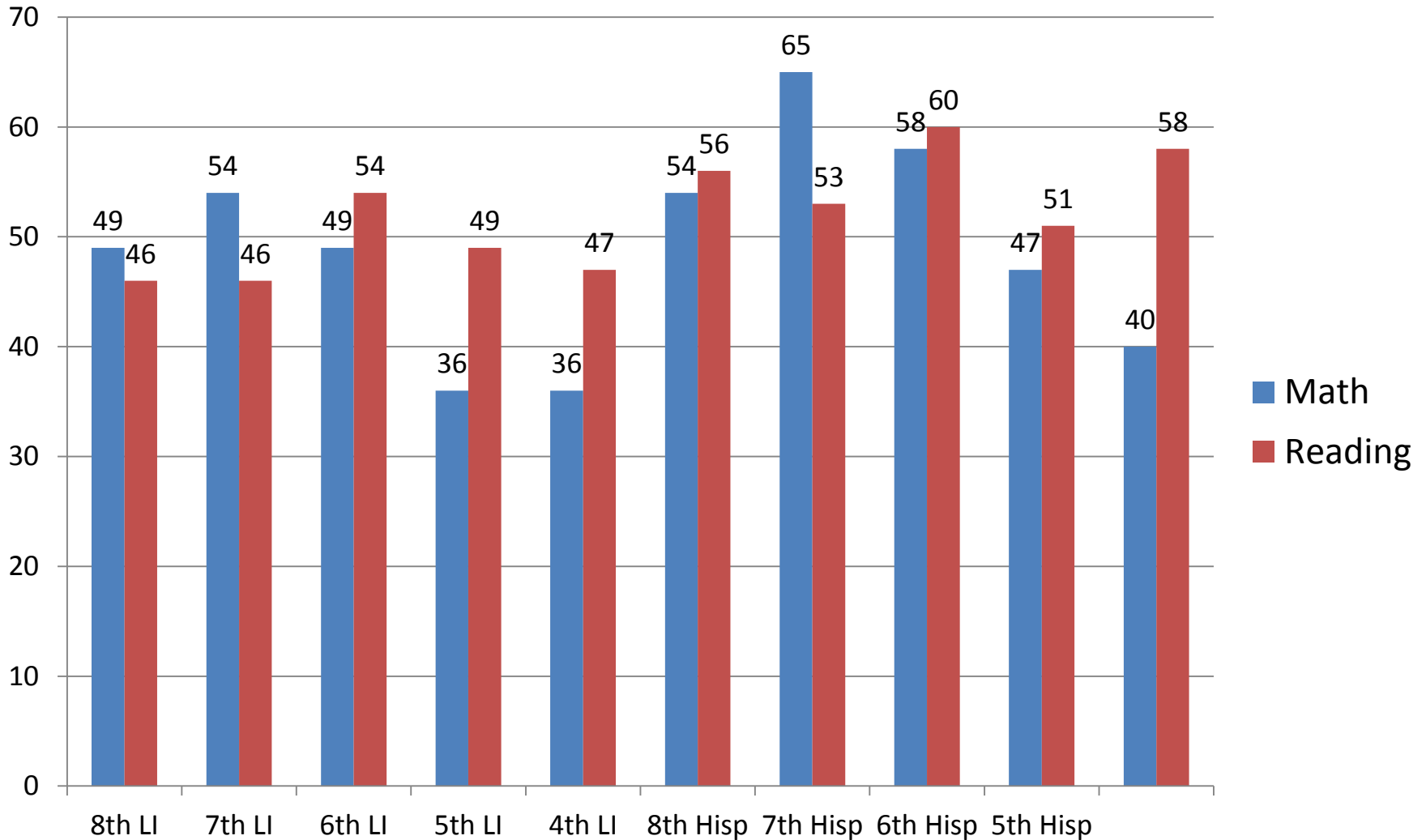
7th Grade Low Income (44) and Hispanic (40) Cohorts – Percentage at or above the 50th percentile on spring MAP.



District 8th Grade Cohort – Percentage of students at or above the 50th percentile on winter MAP. N=108



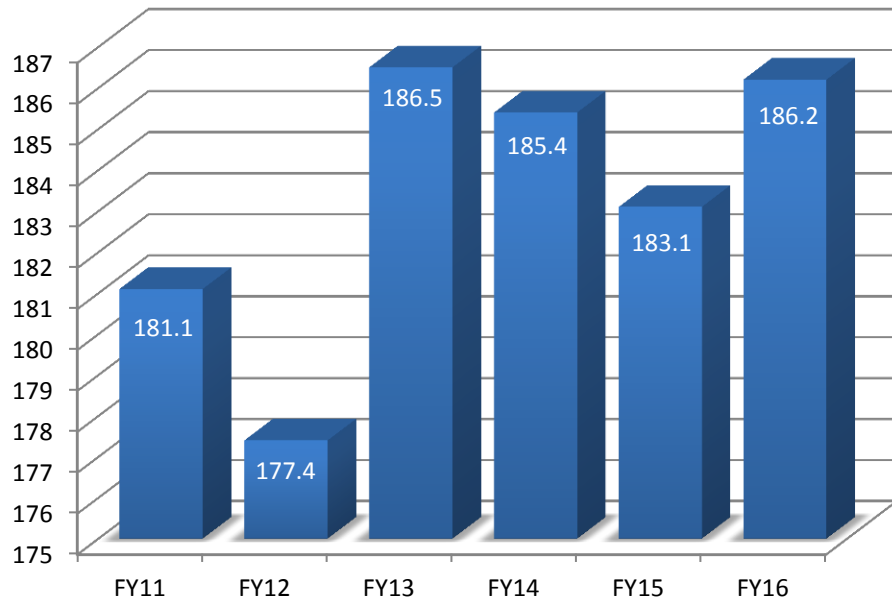
8th Grade Low Income (39) and Hispanic (43) Cohorts –
Percentage at or above the 50th percentile on winter MAP.



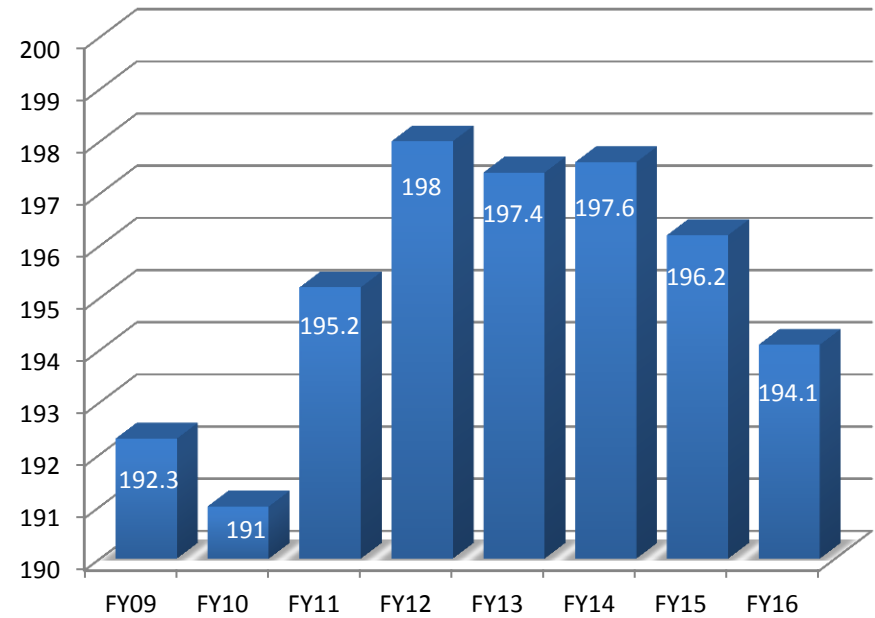
