- Greatest progress seen in:
  - 1-19 percentile range at 81%
  - 90+ percentile range at 76%
- Overall, 72% of students in 1-49 percentile ranges made annual progress
- Overall, 71% of students in 50-99 percentile ranges made annual progress


### Reading

- Greatest progress seen in 20-49 percentile ranges at 72%
- Overall, 71% of students in the 1-49 percentile ranges made annual progress
- Overall, 55% of students in 50-99 percentile ranges are making annual progress
- FY16 - Critical focus on the annual growth of students in 90+ percentile range



## *Percentage of Students Meeting Annual Progress Target in Each Percentile Range*




# District 105 Math Progress Fall-Spring FY15






# District 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Cohort - Percentage of students at or above 50<sup>th</sup> percentile n=128






# District 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Cohort - Percentage of students at or above 50<sup>th</sup> percentile n=128






# District 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Cohort Percentage of students at or above 50<sup>th</sup> percentile n=122






# District 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Cohort – Percentage of students at or above the 50<sup>th</sup> percentile on spring MAP. N=118
