


1st-4th Grade Students AT or ABOVE national averages on MAP Reading Assessment


5th-8th Grade Students AT or ABOVE national averages on <u>MAP Reading</u> Assessment


1st-4th Grade Students AT or ABOVE national averages on MAP Math Assessment






